The background, sashing and neutral fabrics are the same for all quilts. Cutting instructions for the different colour options are provided separately.

From the 1318-G fabric cut: 6 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares 22 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares



From the 1316-K, and 1317-G fabric cut: 16 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares





From the 1317-C fabric cut: 8 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares





Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated. Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

#### Flying Geese Blocks Make 4 flying geese for each block


Take 1 white 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and 2 coloured 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.





Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectange, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.












Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line. Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.

Block should measure 6 1/2" x 3 1/2".








Take your neutral and/or colured 3 ½" squares, and sew together into a 4 patch block. Press. **\*Follow the diagrams on the next page for fabric placement for each colourway.** 


Take 2 flying geese blocks and sew a white 3 1/2" square to each end. Press.

Add a flying geese block to the top and bottom of the 4 patch block. Press.



Sew three rows of sashing strips and 3 1/2" squares together following the diagram (switch your colours according to the version you are making). Press.


Add sashing between blocks as shown. Press.

Sew your rows together to complete your quilt top.



Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
