

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the white solid coloured fabric cut:

25 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips

20 4 ½" x 3" rectangles

40 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

From 9 patterned main fabrics cut:

4 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the remaining 2 patterned fabrics cut:

2 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

NOTE: pay attention when using directional prints before cutting your present pieces.

From each of the 9 coloured solid fabrics cut:

3 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

6 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

NOTE: You will have some spare pieces left over

From the dot fabric cut:

18 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

6 14 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares


Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

Flying Geese Blocks Make 20 flying geese using the solid coloured fabric


Take one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " white rectangle and 2 solid colour $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.






Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectange, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.


Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.









Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line. Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.









Make 20 flying geese blocks in total using the coloured and white fabrics.


Make 20 present blocks using 2 matching patterned fabric pieces, 2 white 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles, one flying geese block and a matching 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip for the centre ribbon. Press.






Assemble your blocks


Add the white 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips, and dot strips to your blocks following the diagrams.











Assemble your rows as follows.



Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.



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
