NOTE: The sashing in this quilt is  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " finished. If you prefer wider sashing then make allowance for more white and red DV048 fabric.



### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the white DV002 fabric cut:

100 4" squares

40 2" x 14" rectangles

From the green DV2226 and sand DV2526 fabric cut:

- 78 4" squares
- 52 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From the antique red DV048 fabric cut:

- 41 2" squares
- 8 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips

From the DV7224, DV7220, DV7226 AND DV7225 fabric cut: 24 4" squares

16 2" x 3 ½" rectangles

From the DV7221, DV7222, and DV7223 fabric cut:

- 18 4" squares
- 12 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles











Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated. Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

#### Half square triangle blocks (instructions are to make 2 at a time).

Place a solid colour and white 4" square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line. Sew the squares a scant 1/4" away along each side of the cutting line.





Cut in half diagonally along the drawn line.

Open and press the seam towards the darker coloured side.

Trim your squares back to 3 ½".





#### PATTERNED HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

Make 12 patterned half square triangles per block, 4 with white fabric and 8 with either green or sand fabric.

Refer to the block images over the page for each patterned fabric to ensure correct fabric placement for half square triangles. COLOURS AND ORIENTATIONS DIFFER FOR EACH BLOCK.

#### EXAMPLE: for these blocks make:









Assemble your pieces to make your blocks, paying attention to the orientation of your half square triangles.

Take your sashing pieces and corner squares and sew your blocks in rows as follows.





Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
