CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR THE SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCKS

From DV6931 cut:	5 x 6½" squares
From DV6939 cut:	20 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles
From DV084 cut:	40 x 3½" squares
From DV088 cut:	20 x 3½" squares

FOR THE RIBBON STAR BLOCKS

From DV6932 cut:	48 x 4" squares
From DV6938 cut:	16 x 4" squares
From DV066 cut:	32 x 4" squares
From DV135 cut:	32 x 3½" squares

FOR THE REMAINING BLOCKS

From DV6938 cut:	4 x 121/2" squares
From DV6940 cut:	8 x 12½" squares

PLEASE NOTE: Final stripe placement of DV6940 blocks will depend on how you choose to cut and rotate your blocks.

FOR SASHING

From DV009 cut:	16 x 2" squares	
From DV002 cut:	14 x 2" x WOF strips	
Crosscut these strips into $40 \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips		

FOR BINDING

From DV009 cut: $7 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips



Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. ¹/₄ inch seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated. Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance onblock layout and fabric placement when working with directional fabrics.

SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCKS : MAKE 5

Flying Geese Units for Star Points

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the wrong side of each DV084 square as shown below. Place one DV084 square on top of a DV6939 rectangle, right sides together. Ensure the edges match up.





Sew along the drawn line and trim excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Fold back and press.





Take a second DV084 square and place face down on the DV6939 rectangle. Sew along the drawn line and trim excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn line. Fold back and press.





Finished size should be $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim if necessary. Make 20 Flying Geese.



Assembling the Sawtooth Star Blocks

Sew the following pieces into rows as shown in the diagram below:

- ROW 1: 1 square DV088, 1 Flying Geese unit, 1 square DV088
- ROW 2: 1 Flying Geese unit, 1 square DV6931, 1 Flying Geese unit
- ROW 3: 1 square DV088, 1 Flying Geese unit, 1 square DV088



Press the seams of Rows 1 and 3 away from the centre. Press the seams of row 2 towards the centre. Sew rows together as shown above.

Press your completed block and trim down to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square if required.

Make 5 Sawtooth Star blocks.



RIBBON STAR BLOCKS : MAKE 8

Two At A Time Half Square Triangles

Place one DV6932 square on top of a DV6938 square, right sides together. Ensure the edges match up. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other as shown below. On both sides of the diagonal line, stitch a scant 1/4" seam.



Cut along the drawn line. Open block, press seams to one side, and trim the block to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Repeat this process to make:

- 32 DV6932 + DV6938 HST blocks
- 64 DV6932 + DV066 HST blocks



Assembling the Ribbon Star Blocks

Sew the following pieces into rows as shown in the diagram below, paying attention to the orientation of your Half Square Triangle blocks:

ROW 1: 1 square DV135, 1 DV066 HST block, 1 DV066 HST block, 1 square DV135

ROW 2: 1 DV066 HST block, 1 DV6938 HST block, 1 DV6938 HST block, DV066 HST block

ROW 3: 1 DV066 HST block, 1 DV6938 HST block, 1 DV6938 HST block, DV066 HST block

ROW 4: 1 square DV135, 1 DV066 HST block, 1 DV066 HST block, 1 square DV135



Press seams in same direction on each row. Alternate your pressing direction on each row. Sew rows together as shown in the diagram. Take time to nest your seams. Press your completed block and trim down to $12^{1}/_{2}$ " square if required.

Make 8 Ribbon Star Blocks.

HORIZONTAL SASHING ROWS : MAKE 4

Alternate 5 2" DV002 strips with 4 DV009 squares as shown below and sew along short edges to form a row.

Make 4 Sashing Rows.



ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP

Sew the following pieces into rows as shown in the diagram below, paying attention to the orientation of your DV6935 and DV6940 12½" blocks:

ROWS 1 & 5: Ribbon Star, DV002 12¹/₂^{''} strip, DV6940 block, DV002 strip, Sawtooth Star, DV002 strip, DV6940 block, DV002 strip, Ribbon Star

ROWS 2 & 4: DV6940 block, DV002 12¹/₂" strip, Ribbon Star, DV002 strip, DV6935 block, DV002 strip, Ribbon Star, DV009 strip, DV6940 block

ROW 3: Sawtooth Star, DV002 12¹/₂" strip, DV6935 block, DV002 strip, Sawtooth Star, DV002 strip, DV6935 block, DV002 strip, Sawtooth Star

Press seams in alternate directions on each row.





Sew rows together as shown below, sewing a pieced sashing row between each block row.



Sandwich your completed quilt top with batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing. Sew DV009 binding strips together along the short edges. Binding strip should be a minimum of 282"/ 7.16mt. Bind quilt and enjoy!
