# CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Cutting instructions for quilt

From the tri panels cut each panel square to 14" (includes 1/4" seam allowance required around each panel).

From the DV7337, DV7338 and DV7336 fabric cut: 24 14" x 2 ½" rectangles

From the DV7333, DV7334 and DV7335 fabric cut: 48 2" squares 6 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares \*Note: you will have squares left over for 2 of the fabrics.

From the pink DV066 fabric cut:

- 64 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2" rectangles
- 64 2" squares
- 7 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips for binding





#### Cutting instructions for cushions

From the tri panels cut each panel square to 14" (includes 1/4" seam allowance required around each panel).

From the DV7336 fabric cut:

- 8 14" x 2 ½" rectangles
- 4 4 1/2" squares
- 1 28" x 23" piece for back of cushion

From the DV7333 and DV7338 fabric cut:

- 4 14" x 2 ½" rectangles
- 1 28" x 23" piece for back of cushion

From the DV7334 fabric cut:

4 4 ½" squares

From the DV7336 fabric cut:

- 8 14" x 2 ½" rectangles
- 4 4 1/2" squares













Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated. Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

#### **STAR INSTRUCTIONS**

Make 16 sawtooth star blocks. For each block you need:

- 1 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" patterned square
- 8 2" patterned squares
- 4 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2" pink rectangles
- 4 2" pink squares





#### Flying Geese Block construction

Take 1 pink 3 ½" x 2" rectangle and 2 patterned 2" squares.

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.






Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectange, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.












Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line. Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.

Block should measure 3 1/2" x 2".





Take the remaining star block pieces and sew together as shown. Press.



Block should measure 6 1/2"

#### PANEL BLOCKS

Take the tri panels and cut each square to 14". Each square will be 13 1/2" finished.





Next, take your 14" x 2 1/2" strips and sew 3 pieces together as shown.



\*Note the orientation of the stripe fabric

Sew your pieced rectangles to opposite sides of your panel blocks row by row, **note the orientation of the pieced rectangles.** Press.

Next, take your 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " sawtooth star blocks and sew to your rectangle strip blocks as shown below. Press.











#### **ASSEMBLING YOUR QUILT**

Take your pieced rows and sew together in order so that your panel blocks are framed correctly.

Press.





Quilt in your preferred way.

Sew your binding strips end to end and add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.





#### **CUSHION INSTRUCTIONS**

Take your 14" coloured strips . Sew your strips together in pairs following the diagrams below. Press.

#### Make 4

Trim your tri panel blocks to 14". Add a pieced rectangle to opposite sides of your panel block. Press.



Take your 4 1/2" squares and add to each side of your pieced rectangles. Press.



Assemble and sew your pieced blocks to complete the front of your cushions.









Finish your cushion by sewing your zipper into your back pieces following your prefered method, or follow the suggested tutorial link via the QR code below (follow the extended zipper version when adding your zip to reduce bulk in the seam).

Sew your cushion together using a 1/4" seam allowance and insert cushion fill to finish.
