# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

**Project size 22" x 34"** *Fabric requirements to make 1 advent wallhanging*

- Minimum 65cm wooden dowl for hanging rod.
- Approx 1 metre of cord for hanging.
- Thin ribbon or string for drawstring bags approx 5 metres.
- 24 wooden buttons to hang drawstring bags.
- Wadding approx 95cm x 60cm
- red embroidery for numbers, or red fabric and heat and bond if you have a cricut machine or similar to cut numbers.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

To make one wallhanging cut:

- 1 panel piece of choice, we used red
- 1 55.5cm x 25cm rectangle of music pattern fabric
- 3 2 ½" strip WOF of DV113 for binding
- 1 60cm x 95cm piece from dv019 for backing

To make the drawstring bags cut:

- 24 9 ½" x 4" rectangles

# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

**Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.  
1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.**

Sew the music pattern fabric to the base of the panel piece. Press.



## Drawstring bags

Place a fabric rectangle wrong side up, measure 1½" down from each short side and ½" in from the sides and draw a line to mark. Snip each line to the ½" mark.



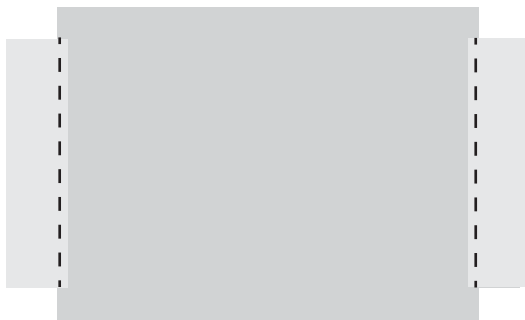
# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS



Fold in each snipped edge. Press.



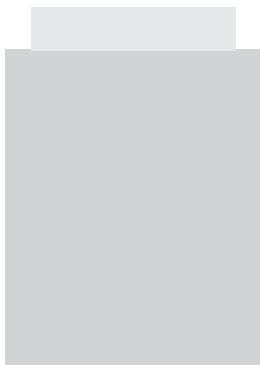
Fold down the side edges 1/4". Press.



Fold down again to just overlap the edge by approx 1/8" and sew in place to secure your casing . Press.

Fold in half wrong sides together, and sew side seams together.

Turn right sides out and press.



Add string into your casing to finish your bag.

Add numbers to your drawstring bags in your preferred way, embroidery or fabric pen cricut fabric numbers etc.

# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste. Quilt your wallhanging in your preferred way, then sew binding strips end to end and attach binding to your trimmed wallhanging to finish.

Sew 24 buttons in 2 rows of 12 to hang drawstring treat bags.

Make a casing for the dowl rod by folding the top edge down to the back of the panel, approximately 1 3/4". Sew across to secure the rod pocket.
