### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- From the pink DV7277 fabric cut: 1 28" x 21" piece for back of cushion
- 3 ½" squares 12
- 5½" x 3" rectangles 4
- 3" squares



#### From the pink DV7271 fabric cut:

- 3 ½" squares
- 5½" x3" rectangles 4
- 4 3" squares



#### From the Teal DV7269 fabric cut:

- 3 ½" squares 10
- 5½" x 3" rectangles 4
- 4 3" squares



#### From the DV7266 fabric cut:

- 3 ½" squares
- 5 ½" square 1
- 3" squares 8



#### From the DV7275 fabric cut:

- 3 ½" squares
- 5 1/2" x 3" rectangles



Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated. Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.







#### Flying Geese Block construction

Take 1 patterned  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" rectangle and 2 contrasting 3" squares. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.







Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectange, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.


Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.











Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.


Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.

Block should measure 5 1/2" x 3".







#### Centre block

Using the same stitch and flip method as for your flying geese, make your centre block piece using your 5 ½" squares and four 3" squares.






Take your  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares and follow the instructions to sew your half square triangles as shown in the diagrams.




#### **Half Square Triangles**

Make your half square triangles following the instructions below:


Place two 3 1/2" squares right sides together.


Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line. Sew the squares a scant 1/4" away along each side of the cutting line.





Cut in half diagonally along the drawn line. Open and press the seam towards the darker coloured side. Trim your squares back to 3" if needed. NOTE: Take care when using directional prints and place face up first then place non directional prints face down on top. This way you know your directional print will always be laying the right way once your triangles are sewn.






Follow the diagrams to assemble your cushion.

#### **CUSHION 1**







Finish your cushion by sewing your zipper into your back pieces following your prefered method, or follow the suggested tutorial link via the QR code below (follow the extended zipper version when adding your zip to reduce bulk in the seam).

Sew your cushion together using a 1/4" seam allowance and insert cushion fill to finish.
