

# Castle Walls

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Quilt Size: 65" x 65" (175cm x 175cm)

## Introduction

Following a visit to the UK Quilt Guild in Yorkshire, and viewing some beautiful quilts, Margaret Mew and I jointly produced our fabric range in collaboration with the Guild, called Peasholme Green. This is one of the quilts I have made with this collection.

## Step 1 - Centre Block

Cut a square in background fabric, Nell (DV7106) 18" x 18". Using 3", 8 pointed star papers, create a star and stitch in the middle of the square.



Now cut this square back to 16 1/2" x 16 1/2".



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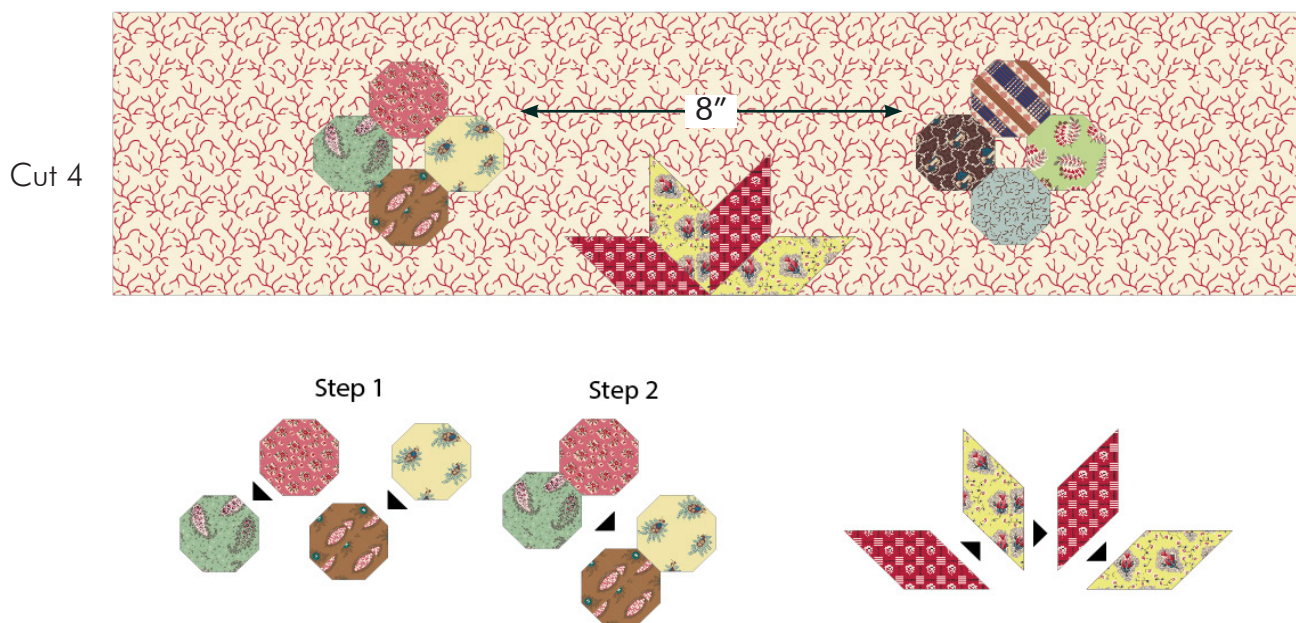
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## Step 2 - Border 1

Cut four strips of fabric at 7" x 30" in Viola Red (DV7126). Paper piece four half stars using 1 1/2" 8 pointed star papers and stitch on the inside edge.

Cover 8 sets of small octagon papers, sew them together and stitch in place.

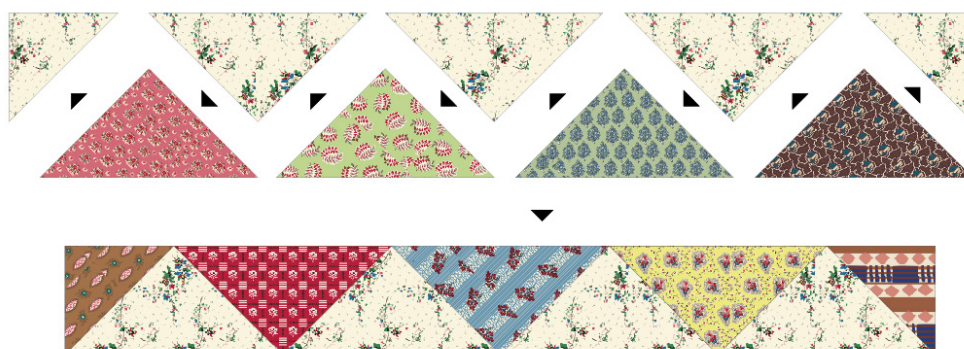
Mitre the corners of this border and trim back to 28 1/2" x 28 1/2".

## Step 3 - Border 2

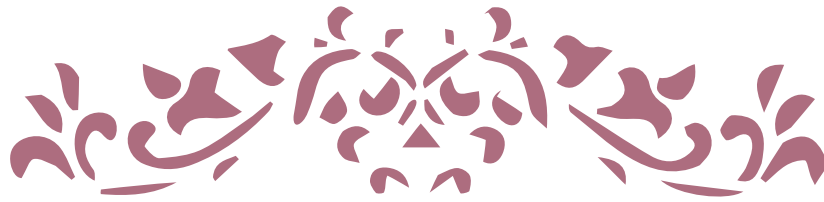
Using the large triangle template, cut 28 triangles in "Nell" and 28 triangles in assorted scrappy fabrics.

Using the same template, create the 8 corner triangles in "Nell" and 8 assorted fabric triangles.

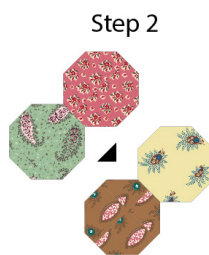
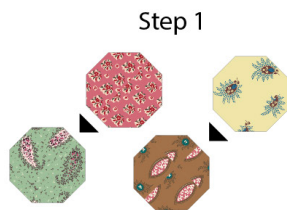


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## Step 4 - Corners

Cut four squares 8" x 8" in background fabric. Using the larger octagon papers, assemble four shapes for the corners, see diagram below.

Cut back to 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" after applique is completed.

## Step 5 - Border 3

Using the large diamond template and inset triangle template cut the following:

- 60 diamonds in assorted scrappy fabrics (14 per side).
- 104 inset triangles in "Viola red" and four half triangles for the corners.

Sew together as follows:

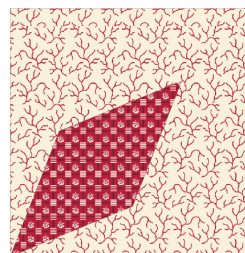

For the corners, cut four squares 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" in "Viola Red". Take four of the diamonds, turn the edges under and press then sew diagonally across the square, as shown, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on the edge.



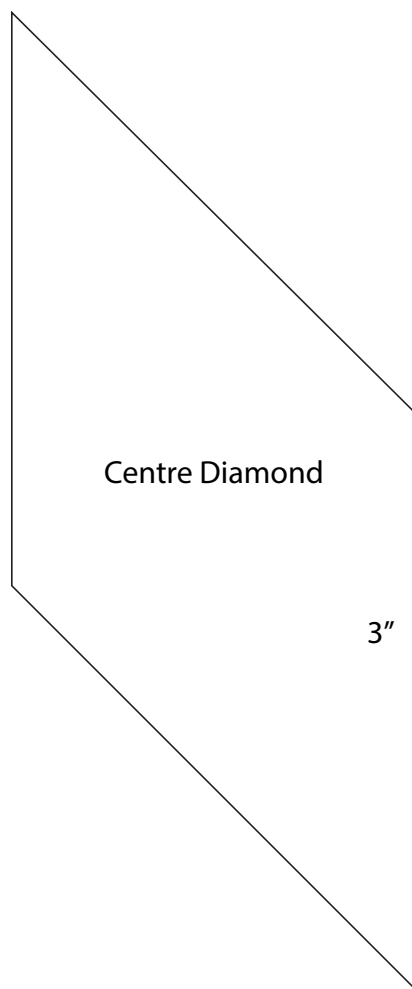
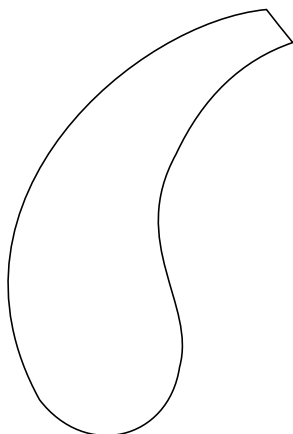
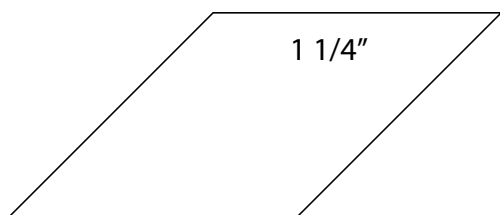
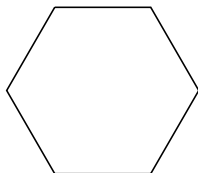
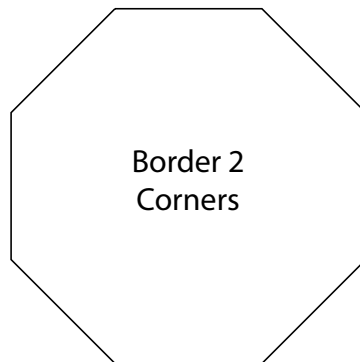
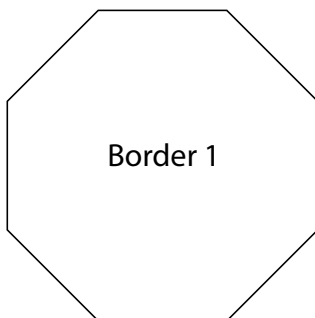
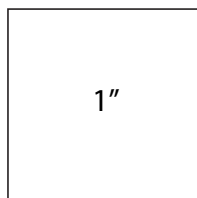
## Step 6 - Border 4

Using 'Evangeline' from the collection, cut 4 strips 5" wide, lengthways and sew on to the edges of the quilt. Mitre the corners.

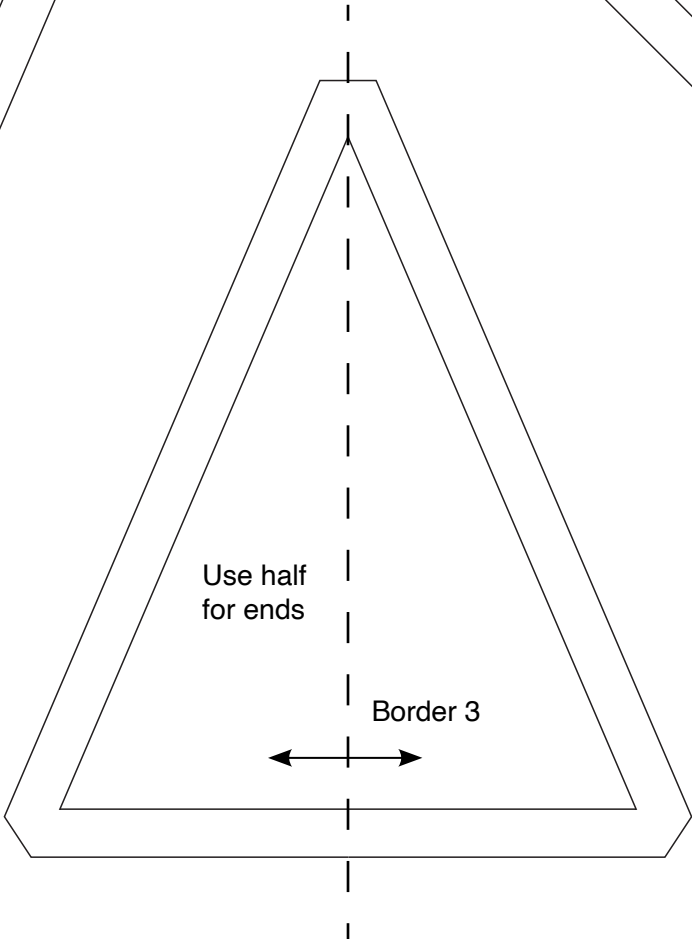
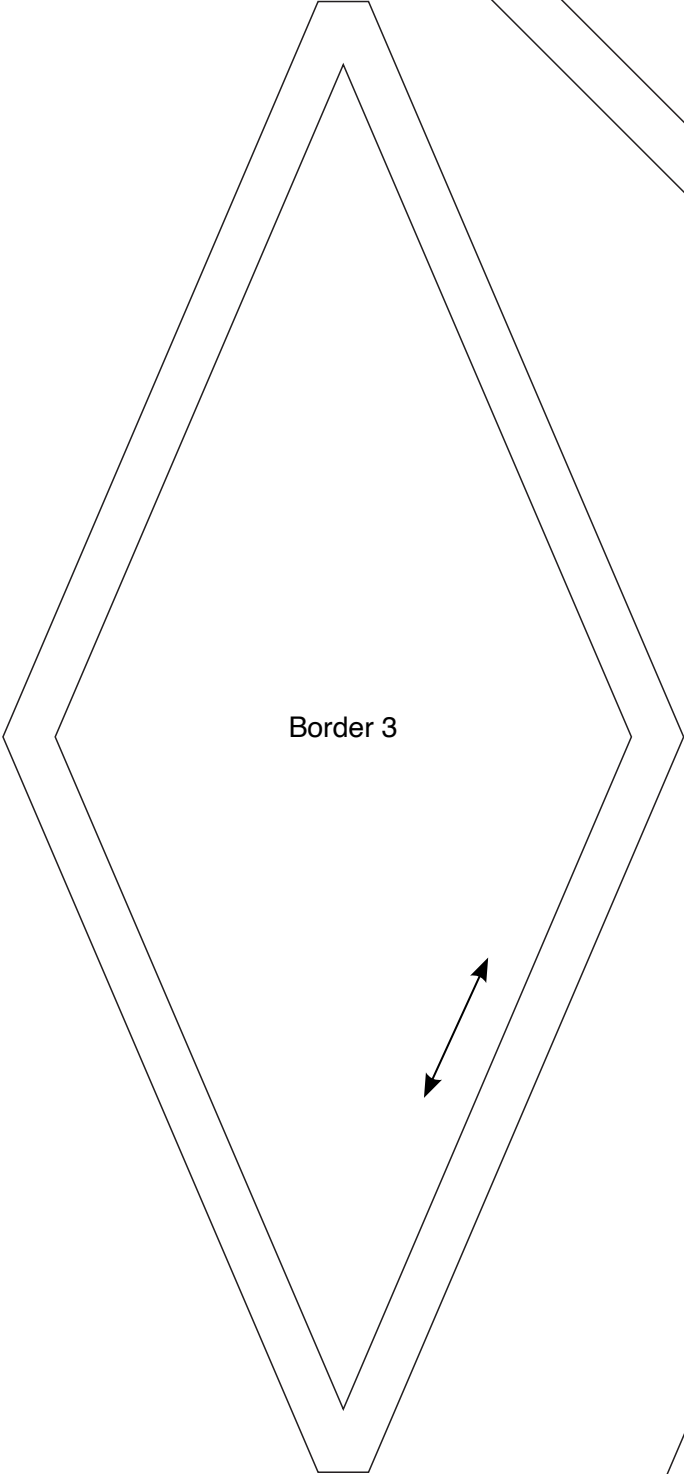
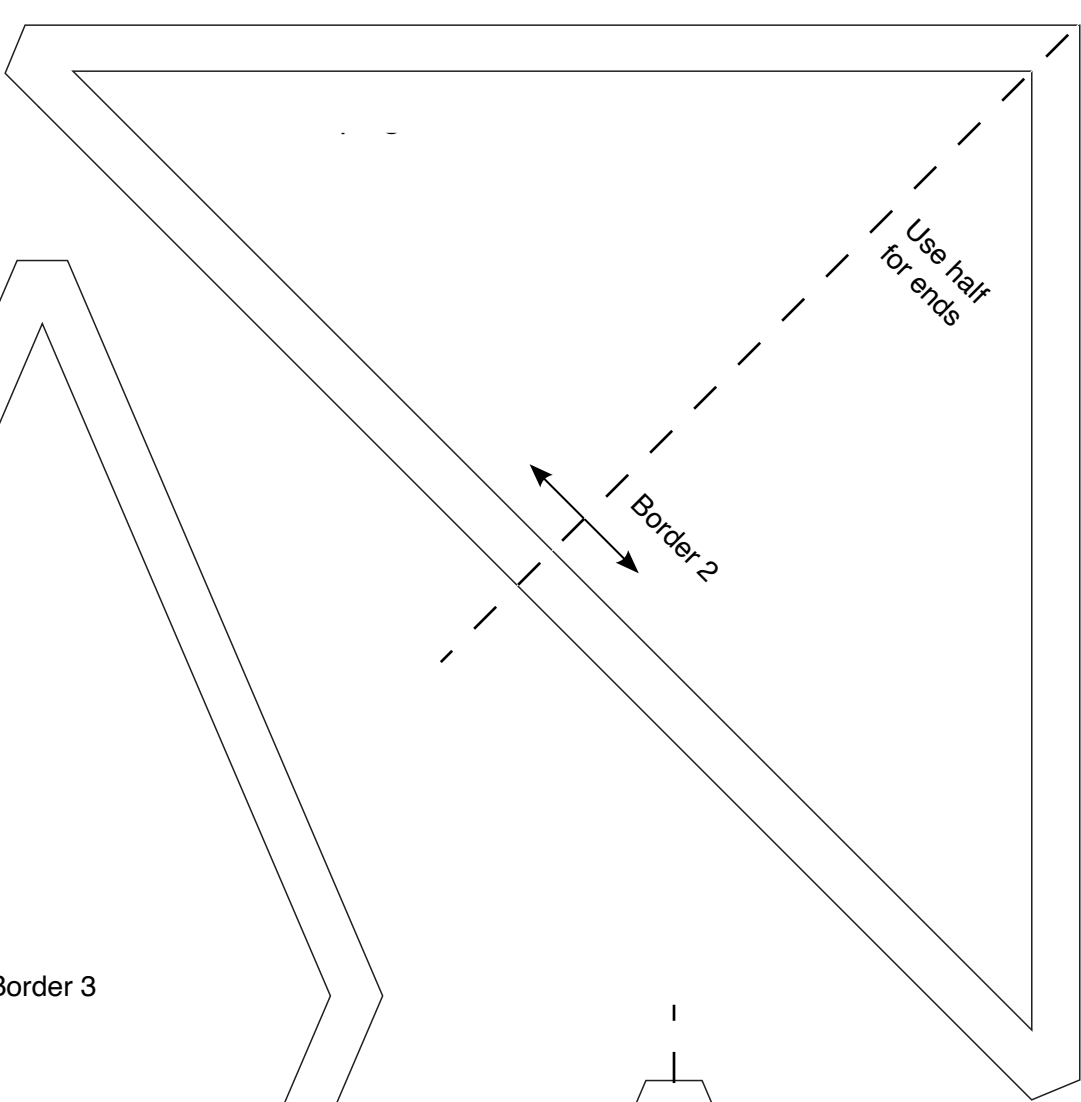
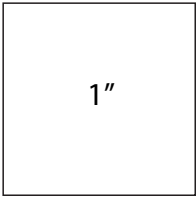


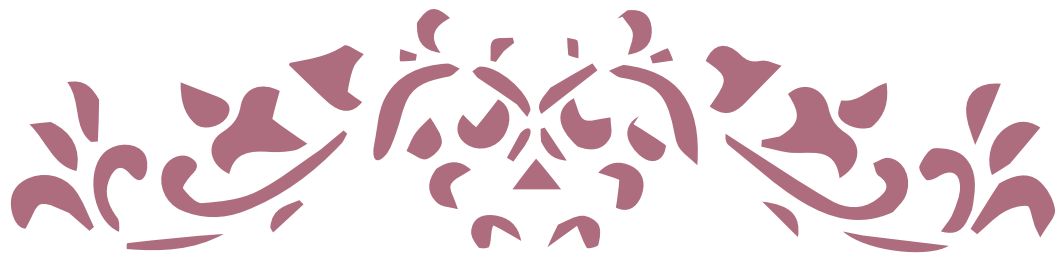

# Materials

**Quilt Size: 66" x 66"" (1.7m x 1.7m)**

- 1st background (centre): 70cm (1 yard) of Nell (DV7106)
- 2nd background: 1.5m (1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards) of Viola Red (DV7126)
- A large variety of fat 1/8ths or other small pieces in an assortment of large and small scale prints
- 2 meters (or 1 metre if you don't mind a join) of border fabric
