

THE FOLLY

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Quilt Station

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Quilt Size

74" x 81" (188 cm x 206 cm)

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Please read all instructions carefully before proceeding

- All piecing is by machine. Rotary cutting measurements include the $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Abbreviations used in this pattern ~

- WoF = Width of Fabric
- s/a = seam allowance
- QST = Quarter Square Triangle
- incl. s/a = including seam allowance
- HST = Half Square Triangle

CUTTING ~

The Country House DV7340

- Cut 4 @ 8" x 2 metre (2 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard) length of fabric. Ensure you centre the main floral section when cutting.

The Manor House DV7341

- Cut 3 strips @ 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WoF, cut into 12 @ 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Then crosscut twice into 48 @ QST
- Cut 1 strip @ 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WoF, cut into 6 @ 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " squares. Then crosscut once into 12 @ HST

The Folly DV7356 (Mauve)

- Cut 12 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WoF, join lengthways to yield 6 strips, these will be cut to length later. They are for the narrow spacer strips.
- Cut 8 strips @ 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WoF, join lengthways to yield 4 strips, these will be cut to length later for the narrow border.

Remaining 20 prints from Inglenook

- Cut a total of 108 @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for four patch blocks.

Binding of choice

- Cut 8 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WoF. Remove selvages and join ends at 45 degrees to make one length of binding.

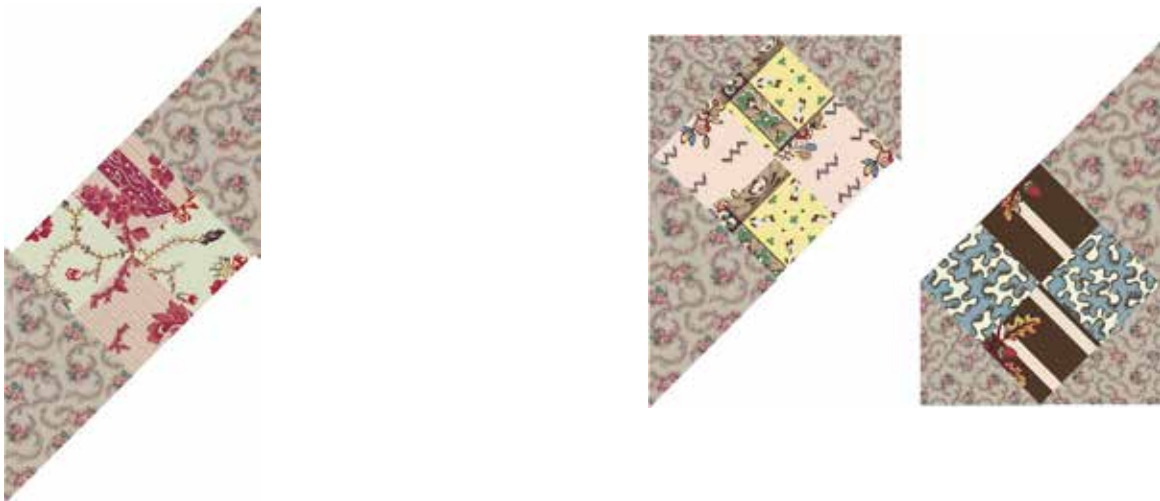
MAKE FOUR PATCH BLOCKS ~

- Stitch 27 x four patch blocks from the 108 x 3 ½" squares. Use two prints per square.
- Blocks will measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" incl. s/a
- A selection is shown below.



JOIN BLOCKS INTO ROWS ~

- Sew the blocks into rows by stitching the QST's to the sides of the blocks. Make 21 sets as shown below left.
- Stitch HST's to the blocks that will be at the top and bottom of each row. Make 3 sets of each as shown below right.



- Sew three rows as shown below



ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP ~

- Your rows of four patches should measure 77" incl. s/a. However, if they don't it doesn't matter. Use the measurement of your rows in lieu of the cutting lengths listed below for The Country House DV7340 and The Folly DV7356.
- Trim the six @ 2 ½" wide strips of The Folly to 77" incl. s/a.
- Trim the four strips of The Country House to 77" incl. s/a.
- Stitch these strips to the four patch rows as shown below



- Trim two of the 2 ¾" wide strips of The Folly to 77" incl. s/a and sew to the sides of the quilt.
- Trim the remaining two 2 ¾" wide strips of The Folly to 74 ½" incl. s/a and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. NOTE, if the width of your quilt is not 74 ½", please cut your strips to the width of your quilt.
- This will complete your quilt top, see picture on following page.



- Complete your quilt by layering the top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
- Once quilting is complete, trim back and batting to be even with quilt top.
- Fold binding in half lengthwise and stitch to quilt as a double-fold binding.



Fabric Requirements

- The Country House DV7340 2m or 2 ¼ yards
- The Manor House DV7341 90cm or 1 yard
- The Folly DV7356 (mauve) 1.4m or 1 ½ yards
- All remaining 20 prints one @ 5" x 21" strip of each
- Binding ~ print of choice 60cm or 24"

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
