


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Quilt size 42"x 52" / Playmat size 40" square



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the grey check DV2935 fabric cut:

62 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles



From the solid DV050 fabric cut:

31 2 ½" X 1 ½" rectangles

5 2 ½" strips



From the texture DV2207 fabric cut:

20 2 ½" squares



From the check DV2207 and patterned DV1064 fabric cut:

4 3 ½" strips



From the patterned DV1060 fabric cut:

5 3 ½" strips



From the patterned DV2236 fabric cut:

5 2 ½" strips



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.

1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

PLAYMAT INSTRUCTIONS

Take your panel piece and cut a 30 ½" square to include 12 handkerchief blocks with a ¼" seam allowance.

Take your check border strips and sew to each side of the quilt, the top and bottom. You may wish to mitre your corners.

Repeat for the patterned border.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS



Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

QUILT INSTRUCTIONS

Take your second panel piece and individually cut out 12 handkerchief blocks with a ¼" seam allowance (9 ½" squares).


Assemble your fabrics and sew in rows as shown in the diagrams.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Sew your rows together, then add your border pieces to each side and top and bottom.


NOTE: You will need to extend your side borders using the 5th border strip to create the extra length needed to reach the top of the quilt.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
