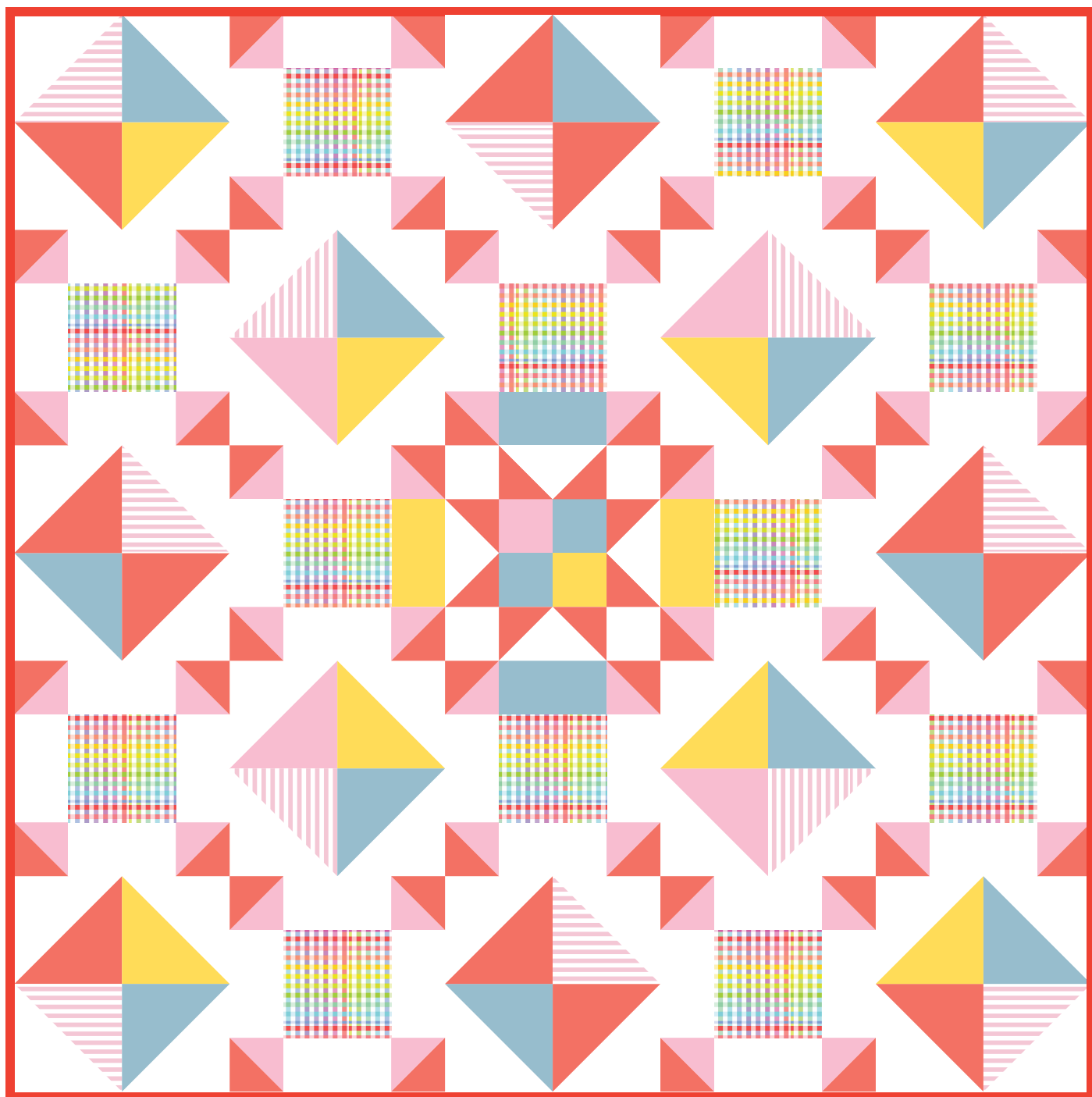

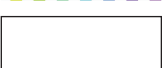

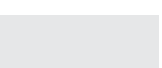

Quilt size 60"x 60"

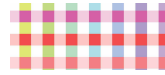

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the rainbow check DV3050 fabric cut:
12 6 ½" squares



From the red DV152 fabric cut:
6 7 ½" squares
24 4 ½" squares
8 3 ½" squares



From the pink DV129 fabric cut:
2 7 ½" squares
24 4 ½" squares
1 3 ½" square



From the pink stripe DV2851 fabric cut:
6 7 ½" squares



From the blue DV104 fabric cut:
6 7 ½" squares
2 6 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles
2 3 ½" squares



From the yellow DV154 fabric cut:
4 7 ½" squares
2 6 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles
1 3 ½" square



From the white DV002 fabric cut:
24 7 ½" squares
48 6 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles
4 3 ½" squares



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.

1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

Half square triangle blocks (instructions are to make 2 at a time).

Make the following 6 ½" Half Square Triangle squares:

12 red/white

12 pink stripe/white

12 blue/white

8 yellow/white

4 pink/white

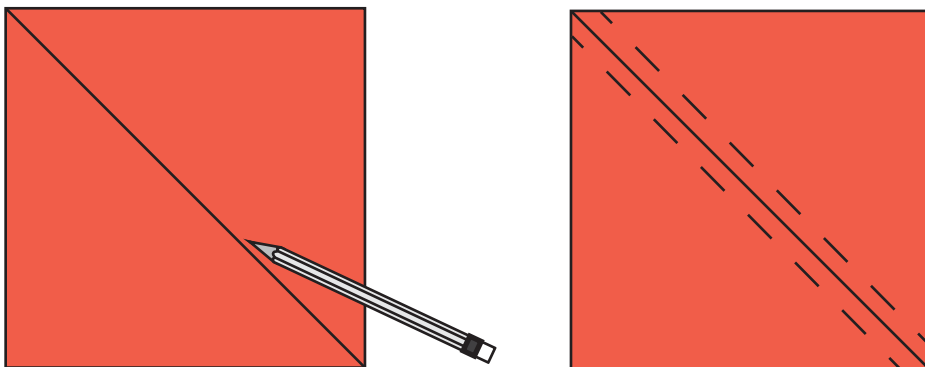
Make the following 3" Half Square Triangle squares:

48 red/pink

Place a solid colour and contrasting square right sides together.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line.

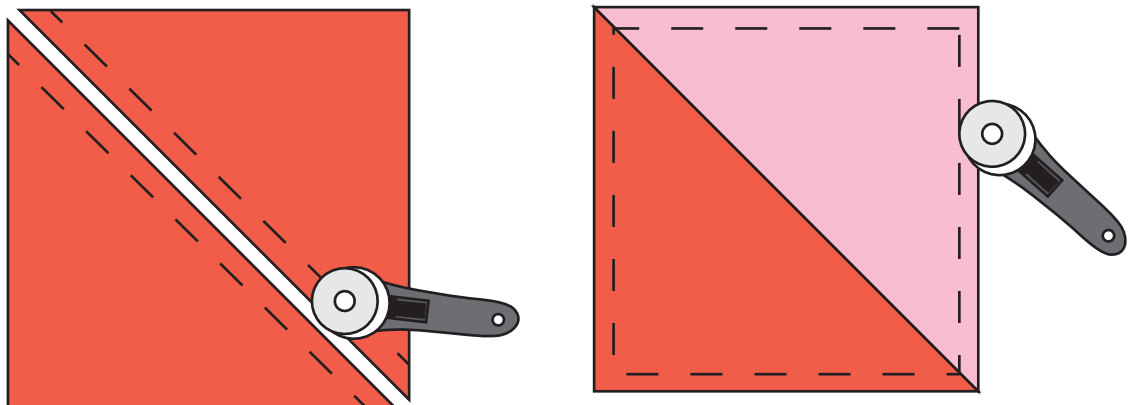
Sew the squares a scant 1/4" away along each side of the cutting line.



Cut in half diagonally along the drawn line.

Open and press the seam towards the darker coloured side.

Trim your squares back to 6 ½" x 6 ½" for large squares, and 3 ½" x 3 ½" for the red and pink squares.



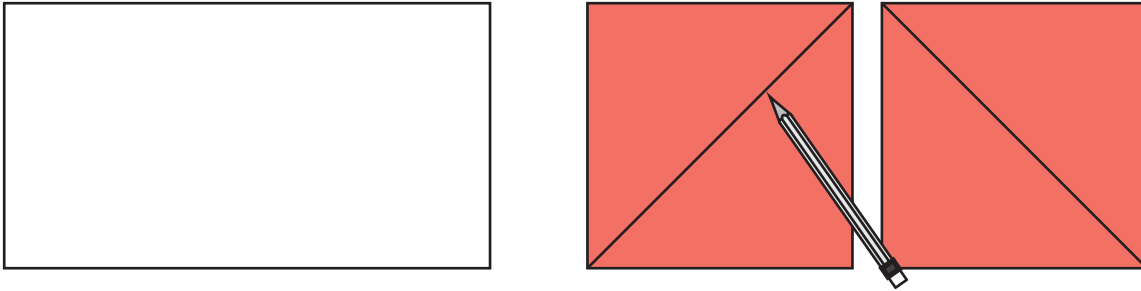
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Flying Geese Blocks

Make 4 flying geese for the centre block

Take 1 white $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and 2 red $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.

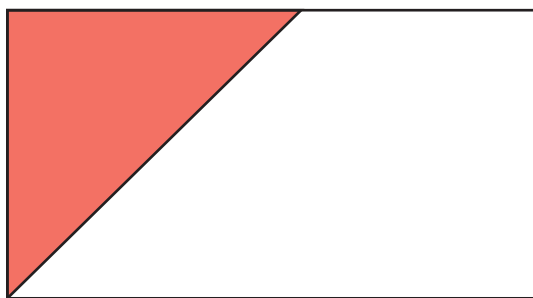
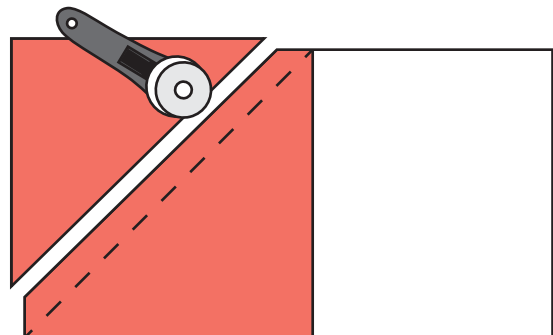
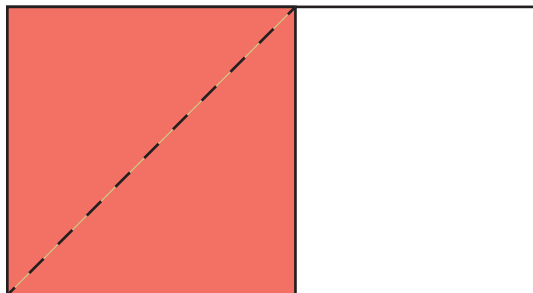


Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectangle, ensuring sides match up.

Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line.

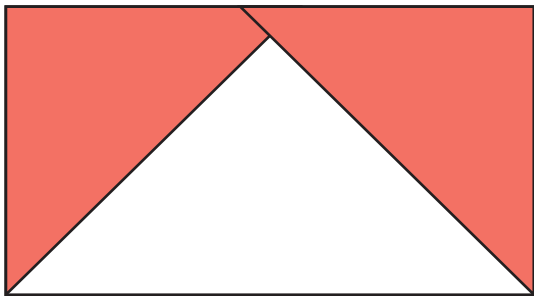
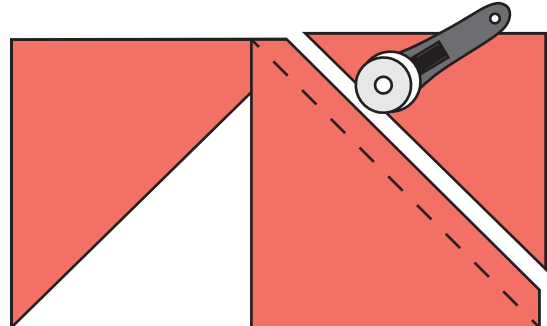
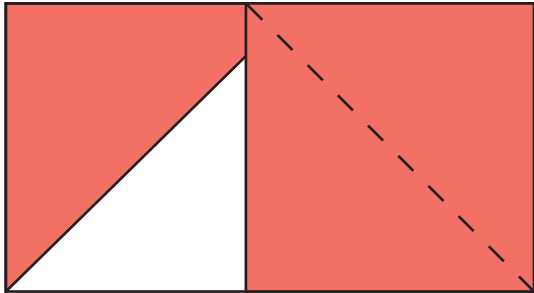
Fold out and press.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.

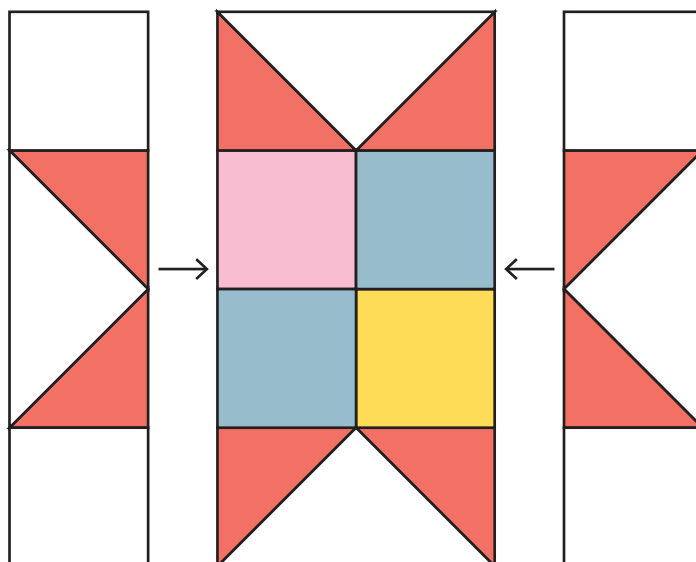
Block should measure 6 1/2" x 3 1/2".



Take 2 blue, 1 yellow and 1 pink 3 1/2" squares, and sew together into a 4 patch block. Press.

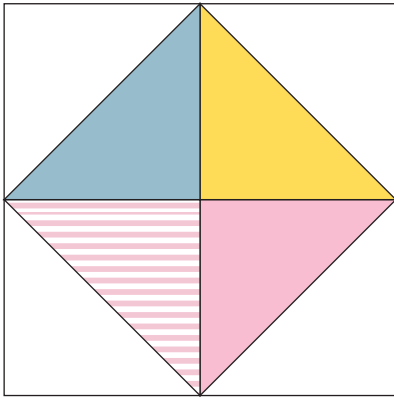
Take 2 flying geese blocks and sew a white 3 1/2" square to each end. Press.

Add a flying geese block to the top and bottom of the 4 patch block. Press.

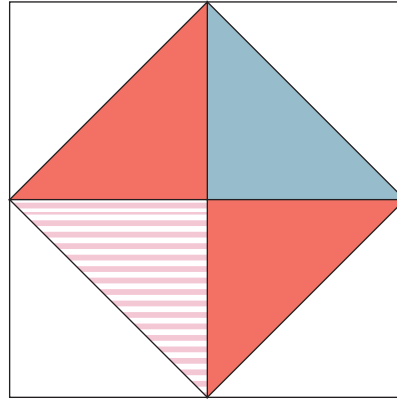

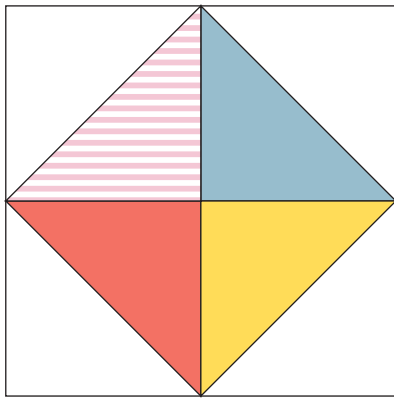
Take your 6 ½" HST squares and make the following blocks:

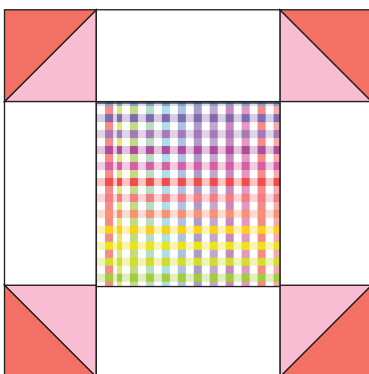

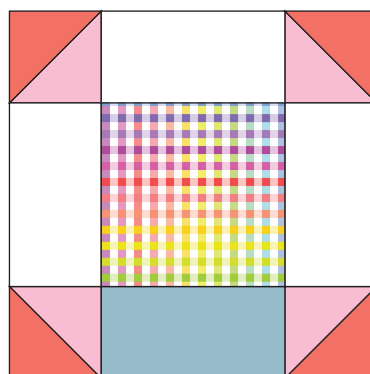
Press.

Blocks should measure 12 ½".

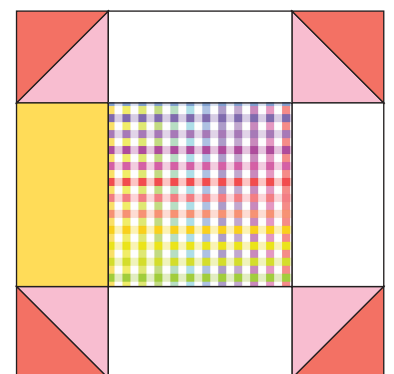
Take your 3 ½" red and pink HST squares, the white, blue and yellow 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles and your rainbow 6 ½" squares and make the following blocks:



make 8



make 2

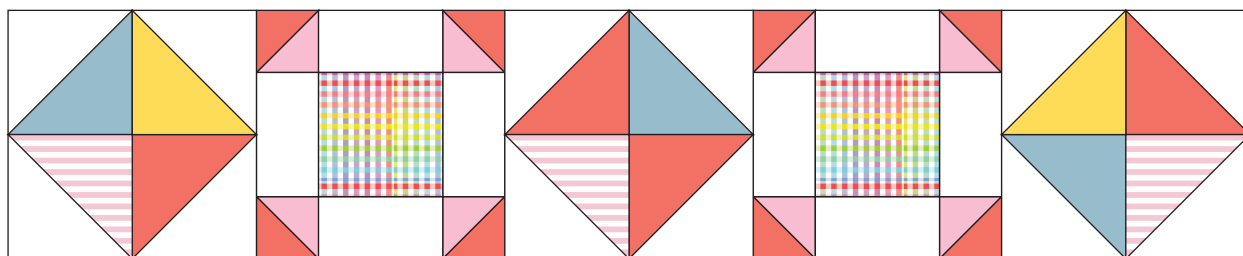
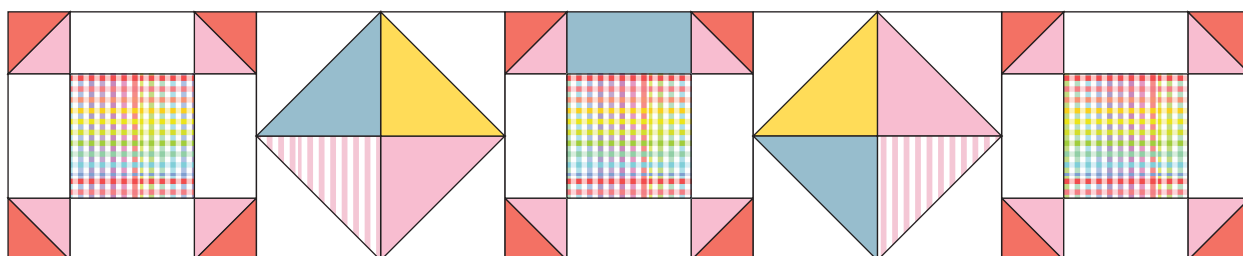
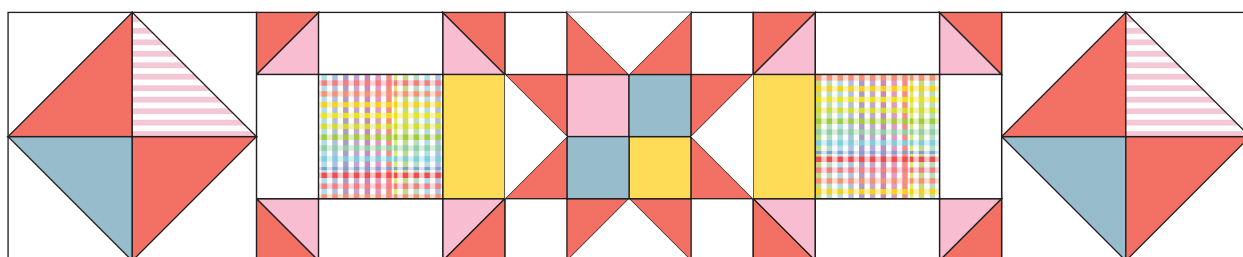
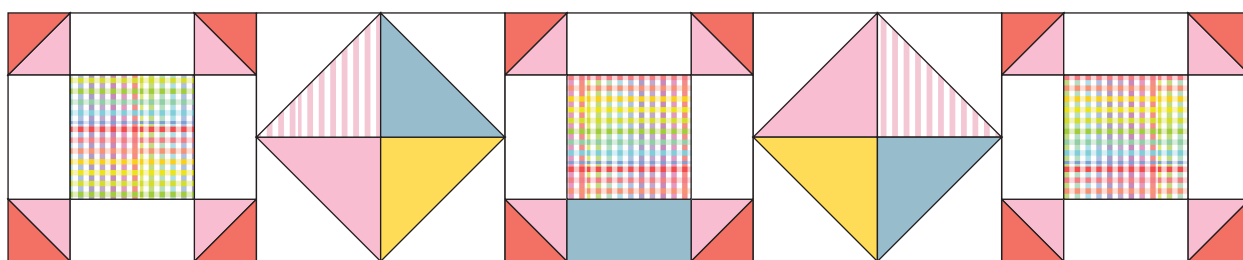
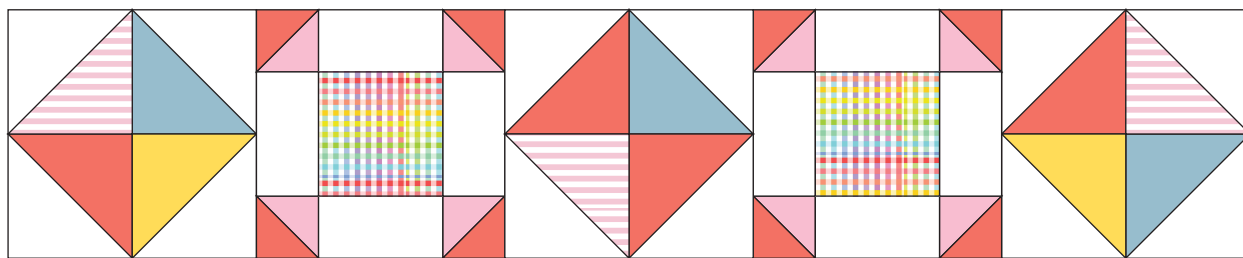

Press. Blocks should measure 12 ½".

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Assemble and sew your blocks in rows as follows, feel free to change the orientation of blocks to your liking:

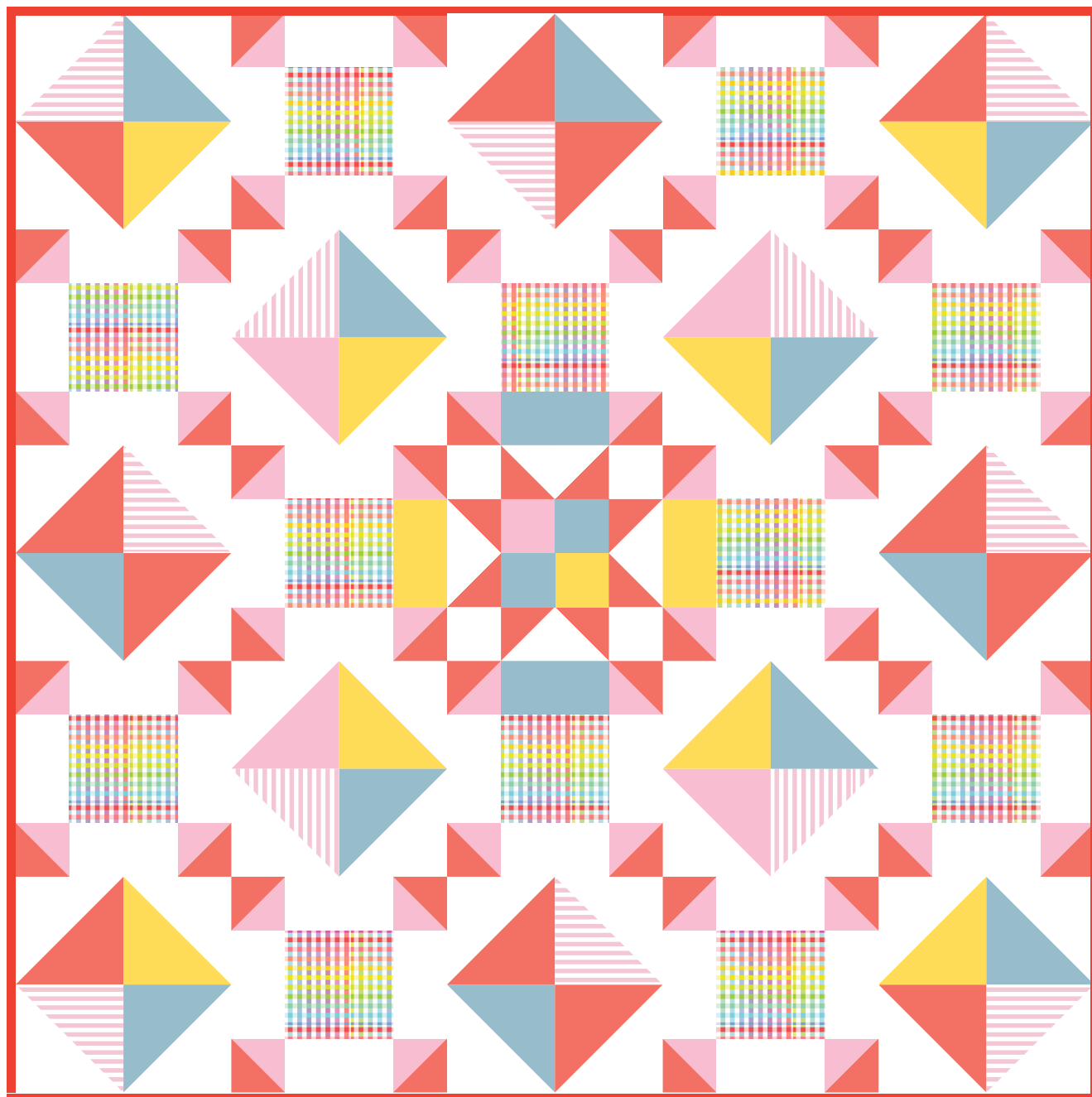


Press. Join rows together. Press again.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
