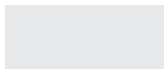

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the white DV7496 fabric cut:

- 32 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- 24 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles
- 328 2" squares

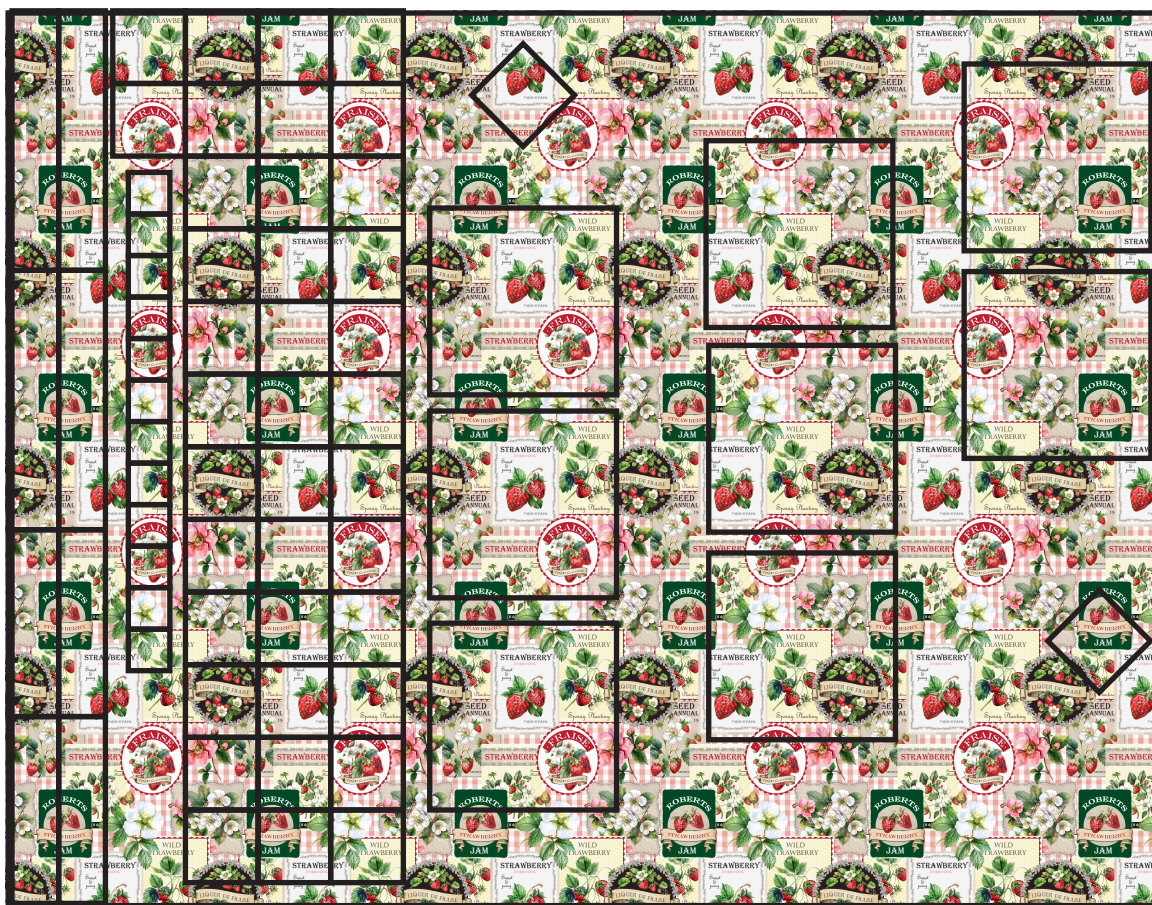


From the DV7495 fabric, use the diagram below as a guide to cut:

- 8 9" squares fussy cut (extra fabric allowance has been made)
- 2 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares cut on the diagonal (see cutting diagram example)
- 38 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 9" strips



NOTE: you will have some spare fabric leftover.



From the DV7494 fabric cut:

- 12 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- 38 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- 4 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 9" strips
- 12 2" squares

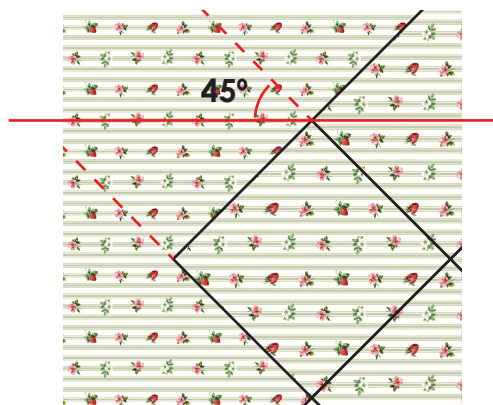
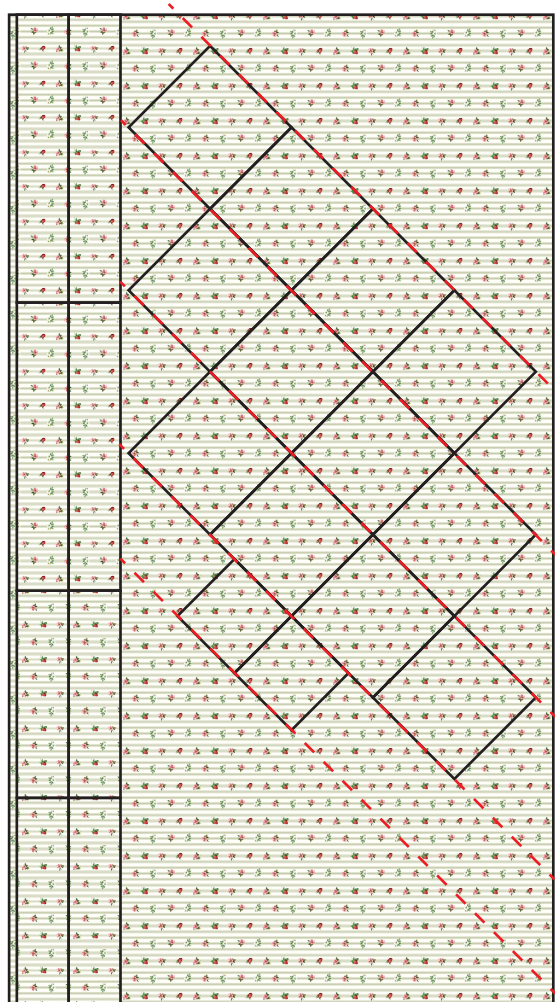


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the DV7498 fabric use the diagram below as a guide to cut:

- 12 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares cut on 45° diagonal as shown
- 2 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares cut on 45° diagonal
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 9" strips

NOTE: you will have some spare fabric leftover.



From the DV7497 fabric cut:

- 8 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- 2 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- 4 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles
- 4 2" squares
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 9" strips



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

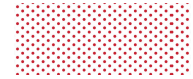
From the DV2844 fabric cut:

- 40 2" squares
- 16 2 ¼" x 12 ½" strips
- 16 2 ¼" x 9" strips
- 7 2 ½" strips for binding



From the DV2844 fabric cut:

- 4 3 ½" strips for borders, sewn end to end



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.

1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

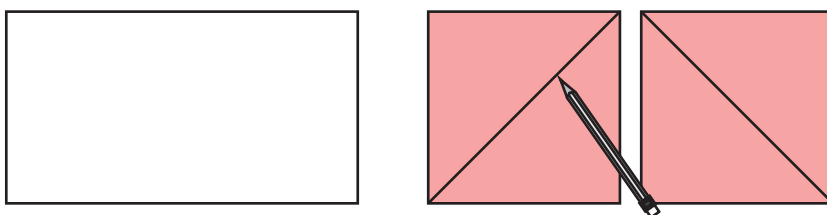
Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

Follow the diagrams to make your stitch and flip blocks using the large 9" squares, the white strawberry print fabric 3 ½" squares.

Flying Geese Blocks

Take your 3 ½" x 2" rectangles and contrasting colour 2" squares.

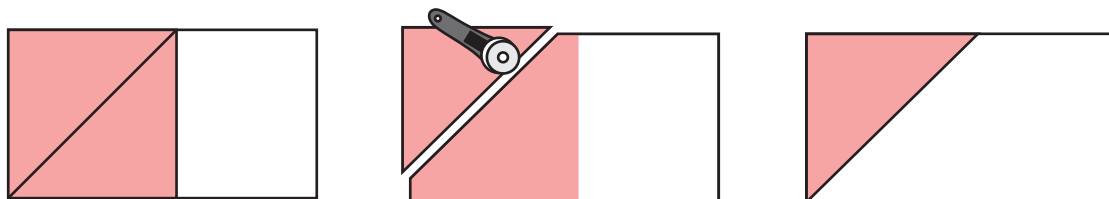
Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.



Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectangle, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.

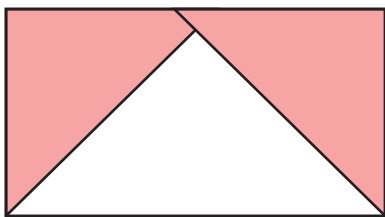
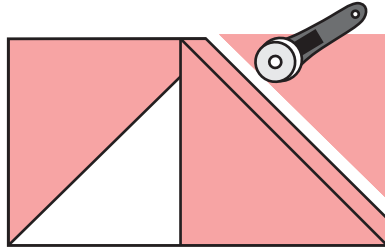
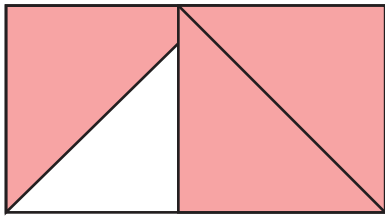
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



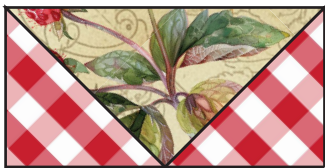

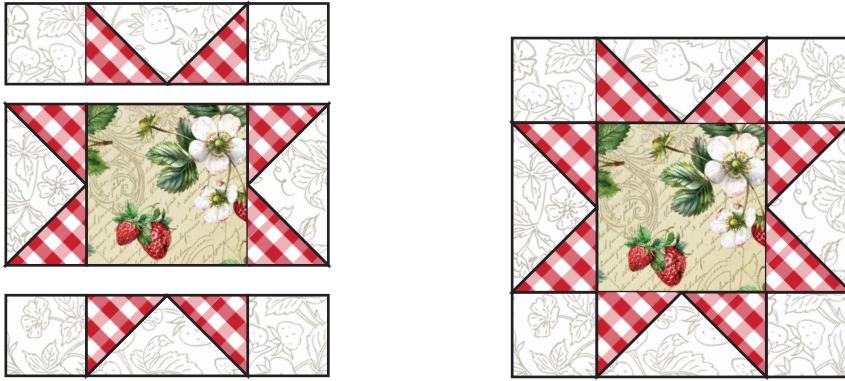

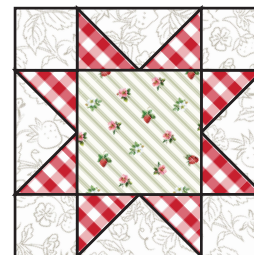
Star blocks

Take your coordinating 2" squares and contrasting 3 1/2" centre squares and assemble and sew your star blocks as follows.

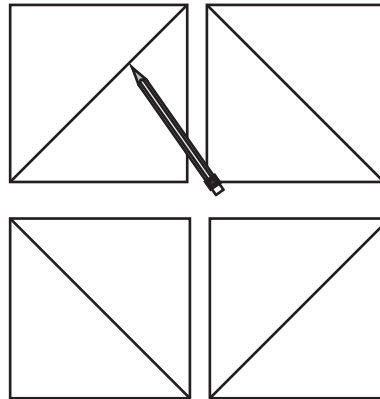
Complete 1 of each of the following blocks.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Stitch and flip Blocks

Take your 9" patterned squares and (4) 4 3/4" constrasting squares.



Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square .

Place 1 square right sides together on top of the large square ensuring sides match up.
Sew along the diagonal line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



Repeat process for opposite corner. Press.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Add your remaining corners in the same way. Press.

Add your check strips to opposite sides of the stitch and flip block. Press.

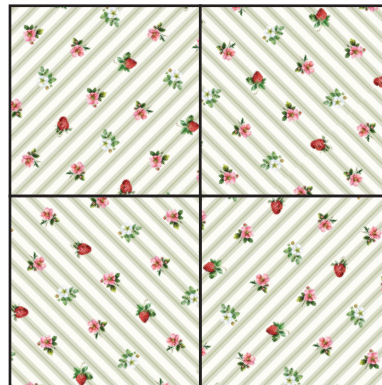


Make 8

Diamond star blocks

Take your sawtooth star blocks you prepared earlier.

First, take your 5" striped squares and sew together in the following orientation. Press.



Make 3

Take the following three sawtooth star blocks, turn on point and glue baste into position. Applique onto your striped blocks. Press.

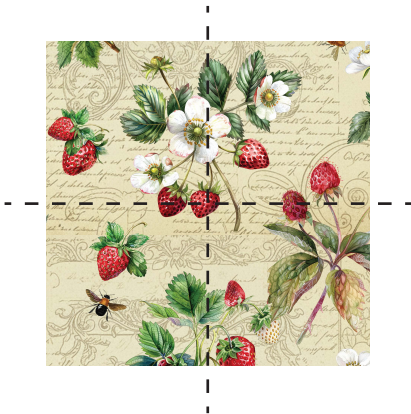


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS



Trim your appliqued blocks back to 9".

Take your remaining 10" squares and fold into quarters and press to find the centre point. Place your remaining sawtooth stars on point and applique into the centre of the background square, following the diagrams overleaf for fabric placement. Press and trim your appliqued block back to 9".



Take your remaining 2 1/4" x 12 1/2" and 2 1/4" x 9" strips and in the same way as for your stitch and flip blocks, add strips to each side of your applique blocks, following the diagram on the next page for fabric placement.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Pieced border

Take your remaining 3 ½" patterned squares and 2" white squares. Using the same stitch and flip instructions on page 8, make the following stitch and flip blocks.

Piece together in 2 rows of 20 and 2 rows on 18, alternating blocks in each row.

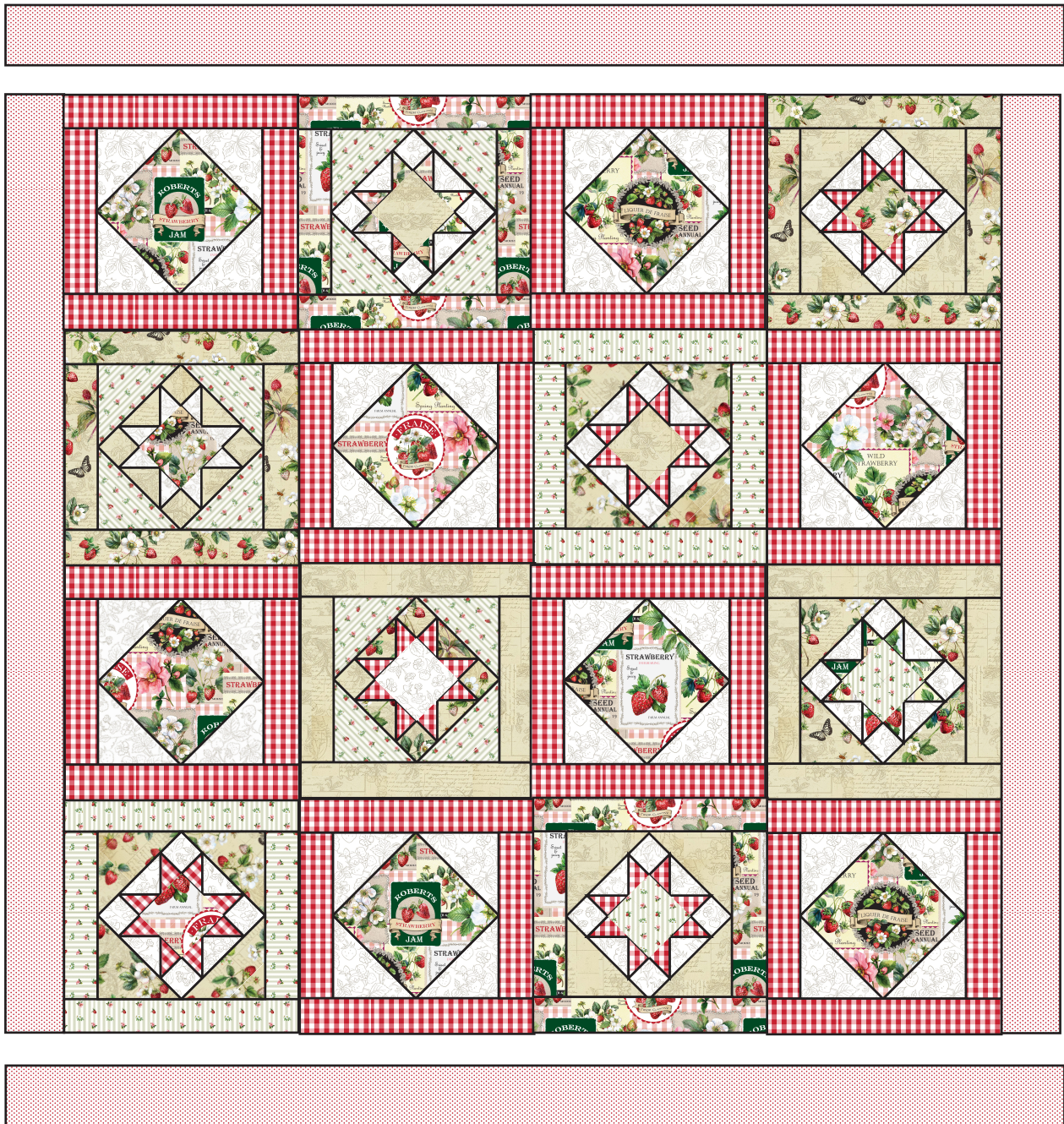
Start assembling your quilt by sewing your large blocks together in rows as follows.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take your spotted border pieces and sew end to end.

Cut into 2 x 55" pieces and 2 x 49" pieces. Stitch your 49" pieces to either side of your quilt. trim any excess fabric, then sew the longer 55" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Finally, add your pieced border strips in the same way, sewing the shorter pieces to the sides of your quilt first, then sewing the top and bottom pieces to finish.

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
