## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

From the white solid fabric cut:

126 3 ½" X 3 ½" squares

From the confetti dot fabric cut:

- 42 9 1/2" X 2 " strips
- 42 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
- 21 6 ½" x 1 ½" strips
- 21 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles
- 84 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares

From the patterned main fat quarters cut:

- 9 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 3 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares

NOTE: you will have some spare fabric pieces leftover.

From the stripe fabric cut:

- 9 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 3 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares
- 6 2 ½" strips for binding

From the red solid fat eighth fabric cut:


21 2 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles


Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

#### Flying Geese Blocks Make 63 flying geese using the patterned fabric, make in sets of 3 for each tree block


Take a  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " patterned rectangle and 2 white  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.







Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectange, ensuring sides match up. Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.













Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line. Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line. Fold out and press.







Make 3 flying geese blocks to sew together to make one tree block. make 21 tree blocks in total. Blocks should measure  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ "






Make 21 bauble blocks as follows:


Take a patterned 6 ½" square and 4 confetti dot 1 ½" squares. In the same way as you made your flying geese blocks, draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the smaller squares. Line your square up to a corner of the larger square face down and sew along the drawn line. Trim off excess fabric ½" from the sewn line, fold out and press. Repeat for all 4 corners.


Block should measure 6 1/2" square.




Next, take 2 confetti dot 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, a confetti dot 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, and a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " red solid rectangle. Sew together following the diagram. Press.

Sew to the top of the square block.





Next, take 2 confetti dot 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" strips, and a 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Attach to your bauble block following the diagram. Press.



Make 21 bauble blocks. Blocks should measure 9 ½" square.

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method. Trim your quilt.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
