

	2 X 18" ZIPPER	45CM	18"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Option 2

From the LO1667491A fabric cut:

- 2 20 ½" x 1 ¾" strips
- 1 20 ½" x 7" piece (for reverse side)
- 1 20 ½" x 9" piece (for reverse side)



From the LO1667491A fabric cut:

- 1 20 ½ x 5 ½" strip



From the LO1667492C fabric cut:

- 16 3" squares



From the L03386404P fabric cut:

- 8 5 ½" x 3" strips



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.

1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

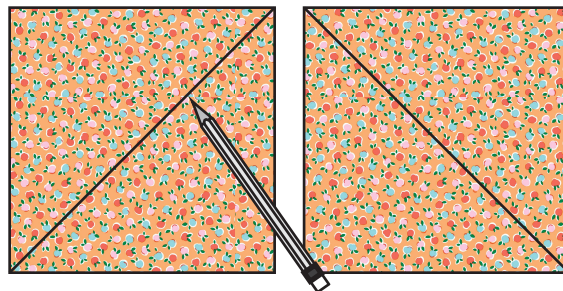
Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

Be mindful of the direction of the grain on the fabric to ensure all pieces lay the same way.

Flying Geese Blocks

Take 1 cream/pink rectangle and 2 yellow/red squares.

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.

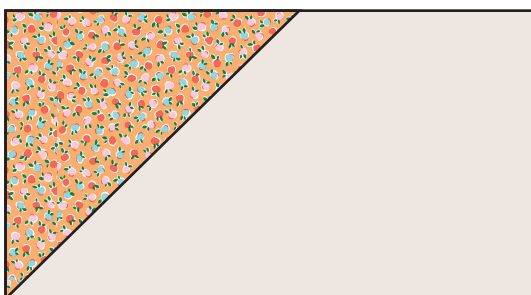
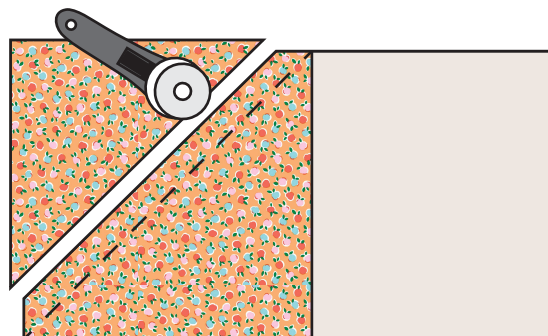
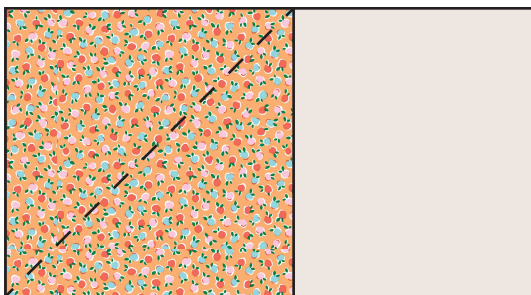


Place 1 square right sides together on top of the cream/pink rectangle, ensuring sides match up.

Sew along the diagonal line.

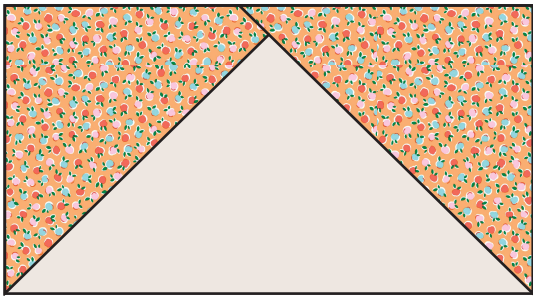
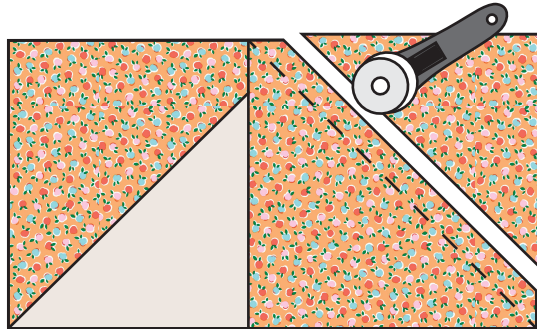
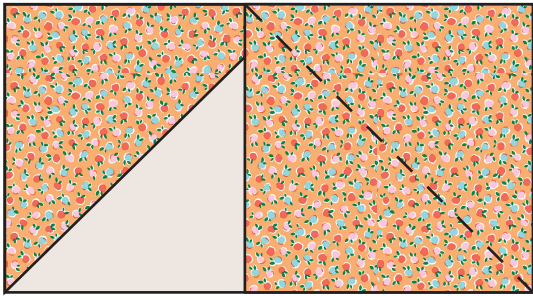
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.

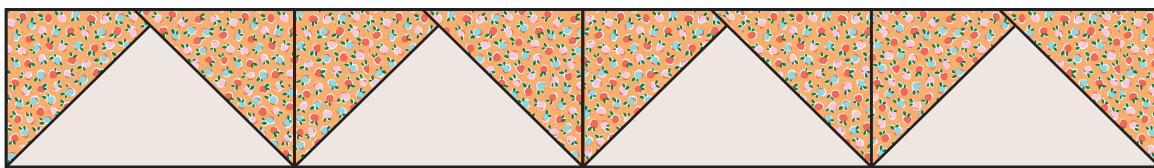


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take the second yellow/red square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



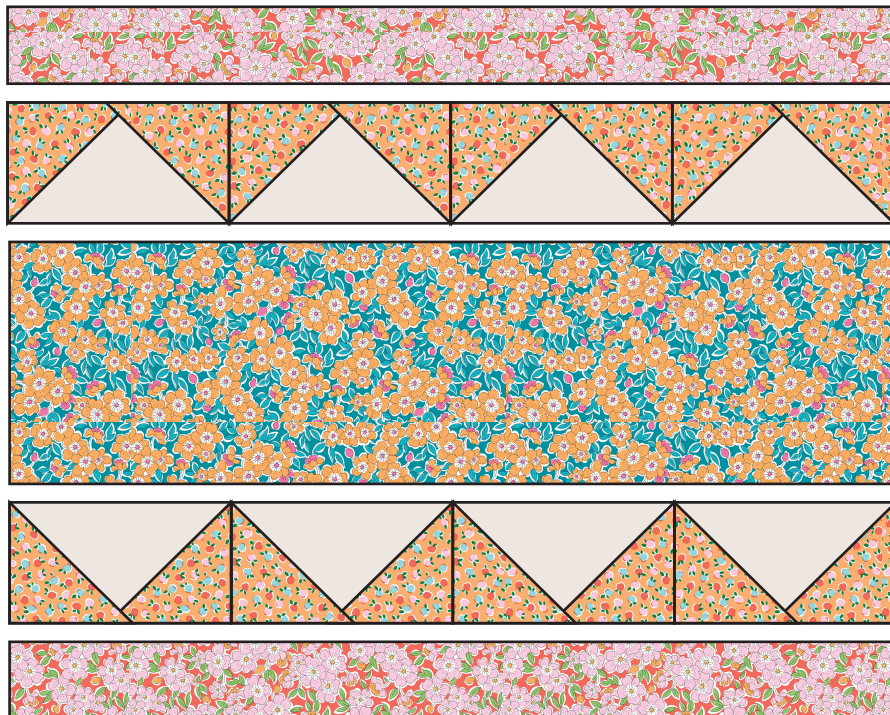
Make 8 flying geese blocks.
Sew together in 2 rows of 4.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Sew the rows together with the 20 ½" x 3" strips as shown in the diagram below.

Finish your cushion by sewing your zipper into your back pieces following your preferred method, or follow the suggested tutorial link via the QR code below (Note: if you follow the tutorial suggested, use the option to add fabric to extend your zipper to reduce bulk in the seam).

Sew your cushion together and insert cushion fill to finish.



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
