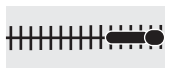

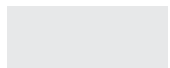
HABERDASHERY REQUIREMENTS FOR CUSHIONS



2 x 18" ZIPPER

CUSHION FILL

55CM X 55CM

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the L01666565A fabric cut:

48 3 1/2" squares

2 2 1/2" squares

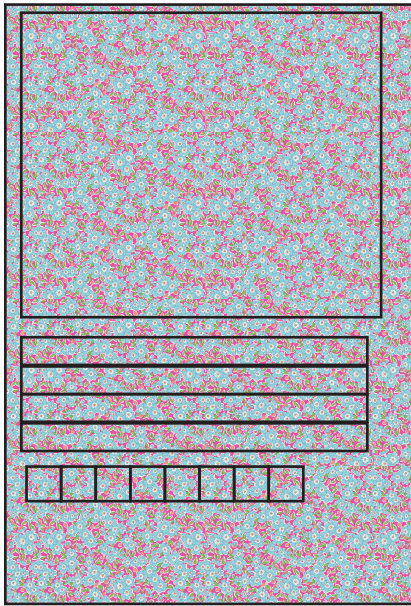


From the L01667491A and L01667492D fabric cut:

1 28" x 22" piece for back of cushion

4 25" x 2" strips

8 2 1/2" square



Cut the large piece fabric this way in order to have enough fabric for your cushion back pieces.

From the L01667493A and L01667490C fabric cut:

8 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles



From the L01667493C and L01667490D fabric cut:

4 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

8 3 1/2" squares



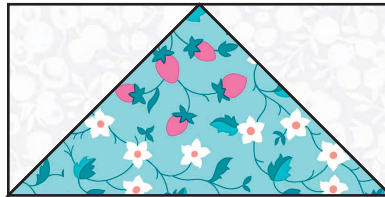
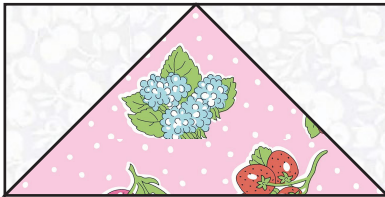
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

**Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.
1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.
Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.**

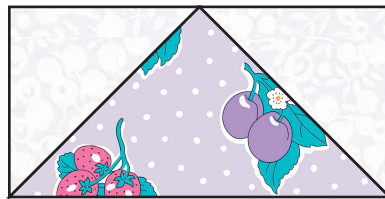
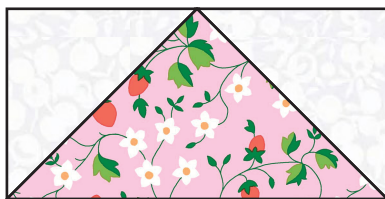
CUSHION INSTRUCTIONS - MAKE 2 CUSHIONS

Assemble your fabrics and begin by making the following:

8 pink and 8 blue flying geese blocks

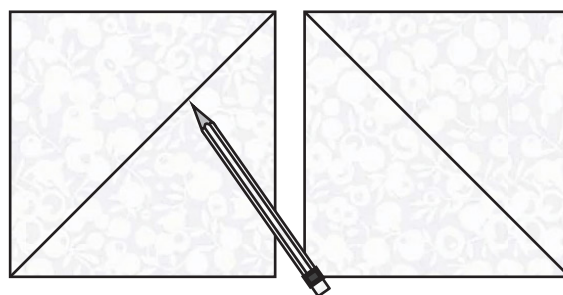


4 pink and 4 purple flying geese blocks



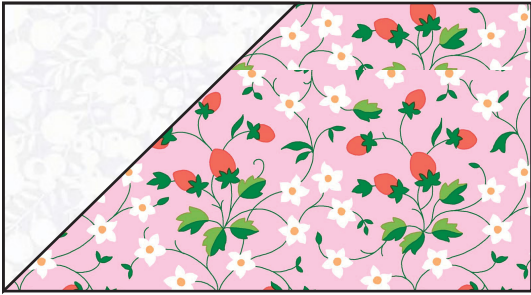
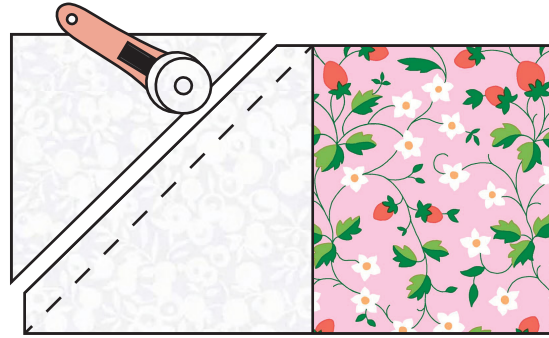
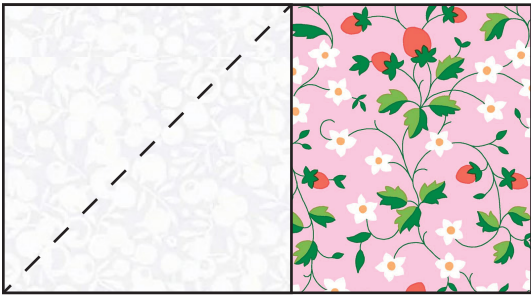
Flying Geese Block construction

Take 1 patterned $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle and 2 contrasting $3\frac{1}{2}''$ squares.
Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.



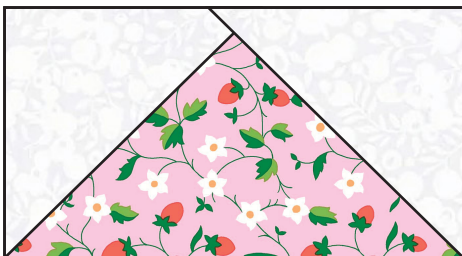
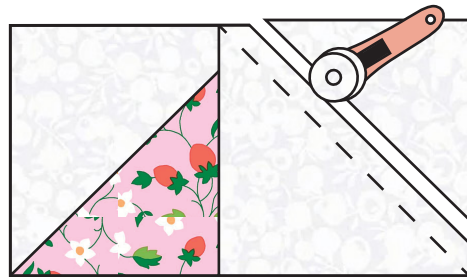
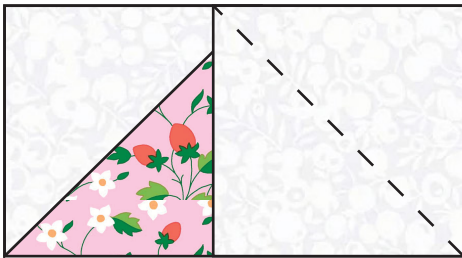
Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectangle, ensuring sides match up.
Sew along the diagonal line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS



Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.

Block should measure 6 1/2" x 3 1/2".

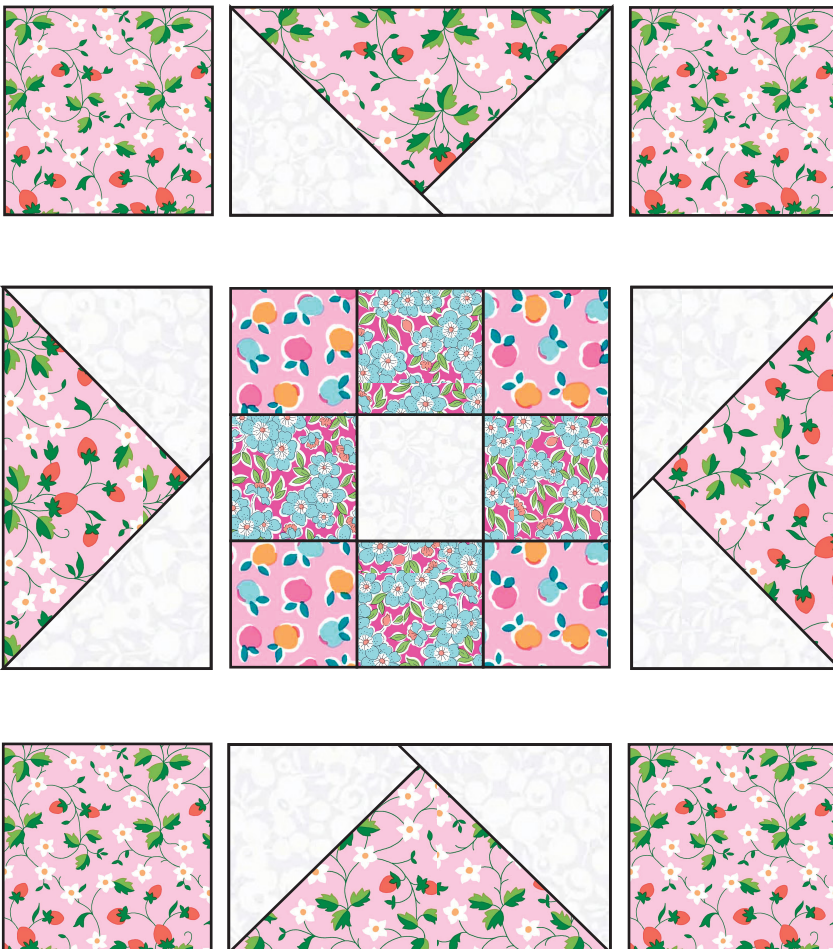


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Next, assemble the following 2 ½" squares and sew a 9 patch block. Press.

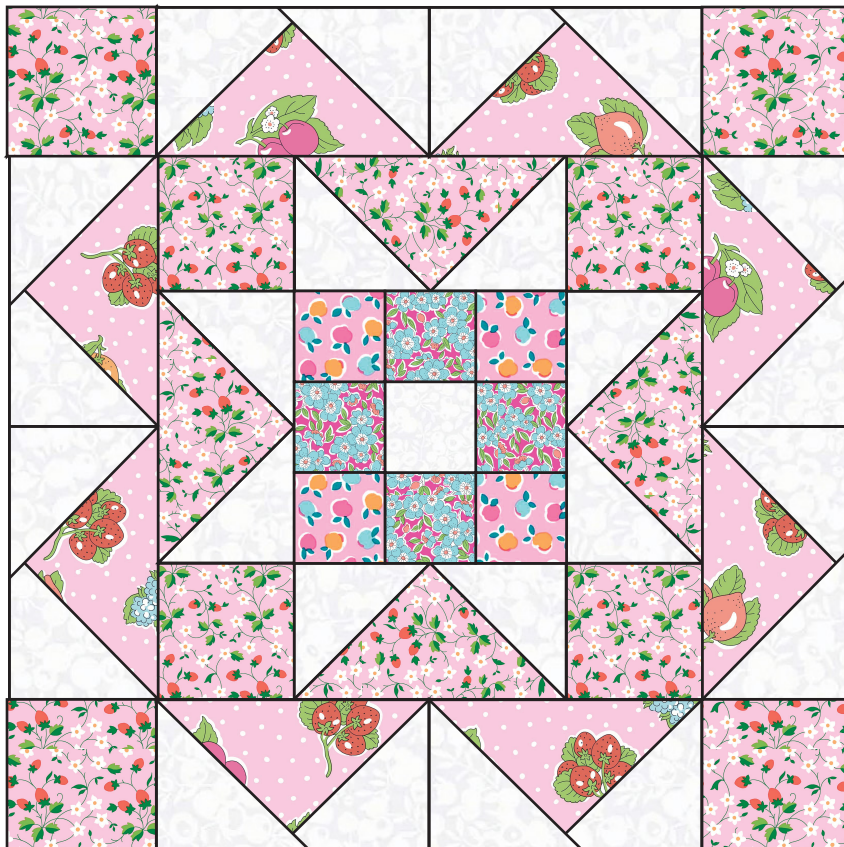
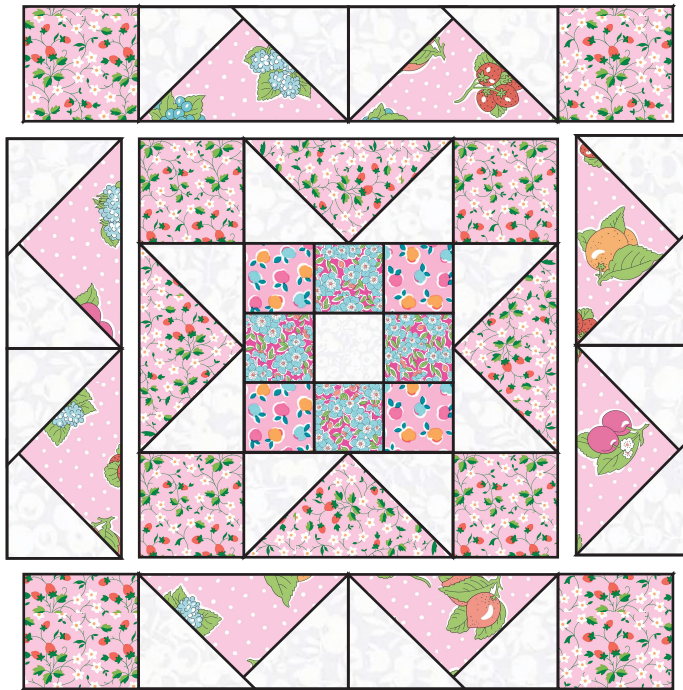


Take your purple flying geese blocks and 3 ½" squares and sew to your 9 patch block. Press.



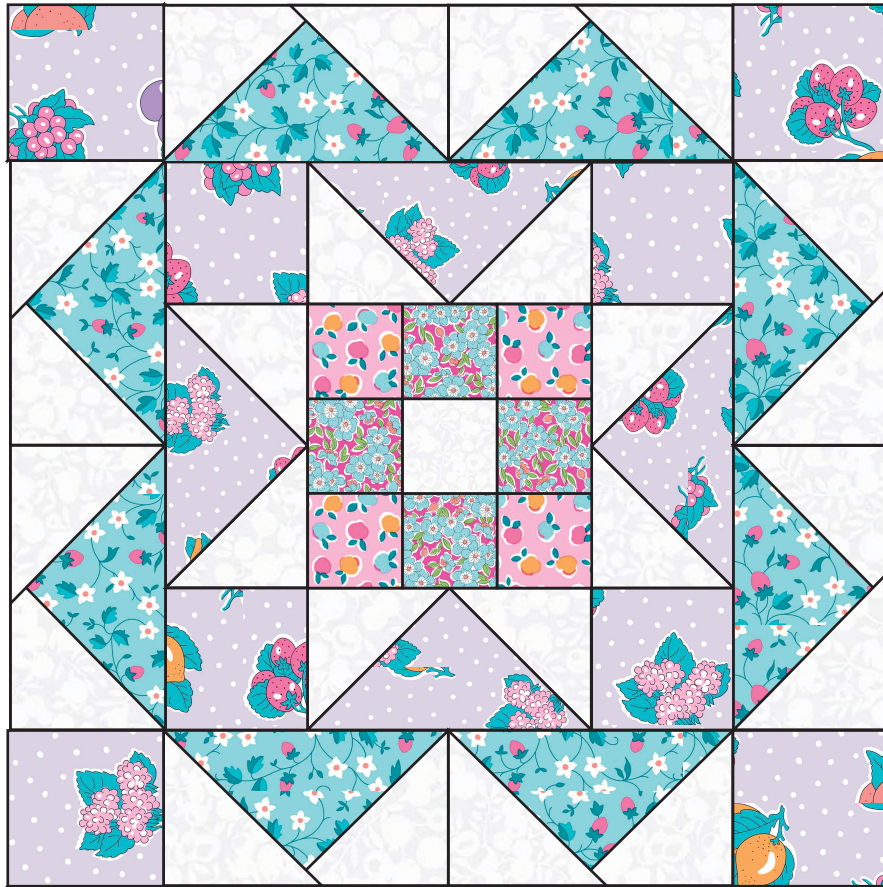
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take your pink flying geese blocks and pink 3 1/2" squares and sew together as shown, then sew to the pieced centre block.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Make your second cushion pieced block in the same way.

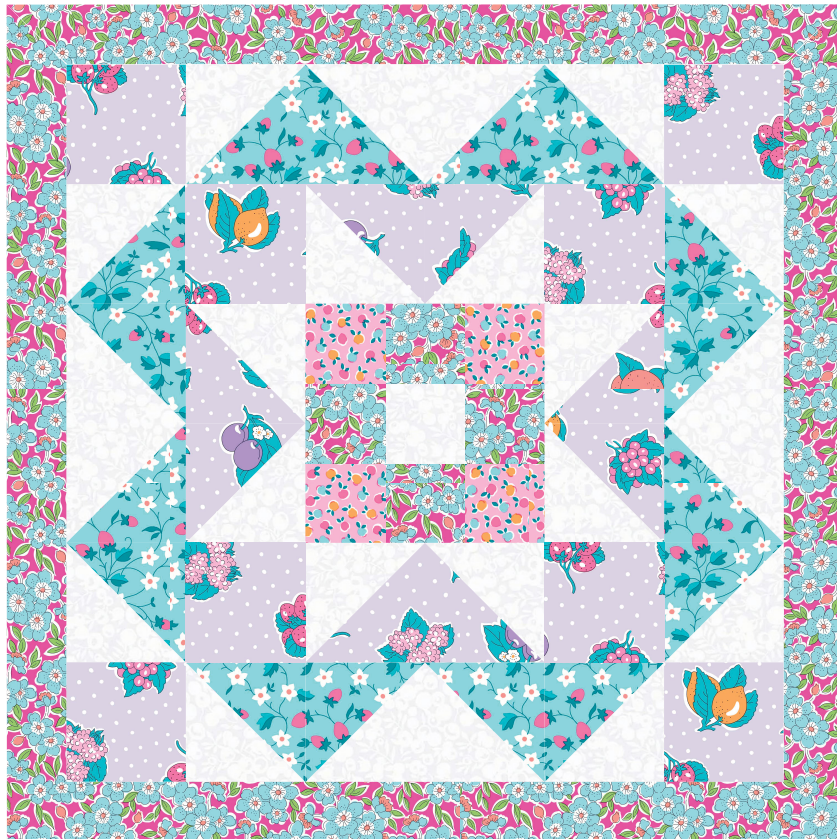


Add your mitred borders to your cushion in your preferred way. Use the following tutorial to help if you are a beginner. There are also many video tutorials on youtube you could use.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Finish your cushion by sewing your zipper into your back pieces following your preferred method, or follow the suggested tutorial link via the QR code below (follow the extended zipper version when adding your zip to reduce bulk in the seam).

Sew your cushion together using a 1/4" seam allowance and insert cushion fill to finish.
