Darling Buds of May

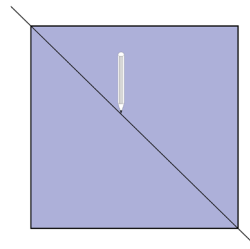
Quilt Size: 60" x 72" (152cm x 182cm)

Here is a charming machine pieced quilt, made from the Darling Buds of May range. It is a simple, traditional half square triangle, scrappy and effective for a more contemporary look in a quilt.

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

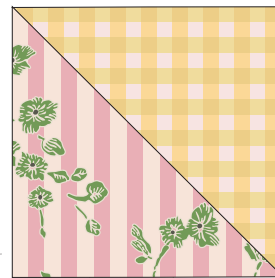
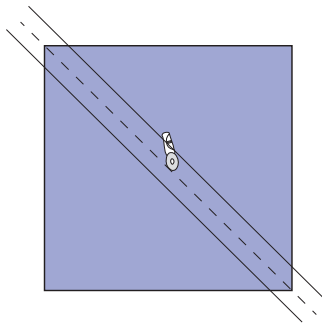
Cut 8 squares at 4" x 4" in one colour.
Cut 8 squares at 4" x 4" in a contrasting colour.
Place 2 squares right side together. On the wrong side a square, draw a line across the diagonal as shown in the diagram.



Step 2

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " sewing machine foot on either side of the drawn line.
Then, cut down the middle of the stitching lines as shown in the diagram below. Open and press.

This will give you 16 squares to make one block. Make 20 blocks in total and trim each back neatly to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " X $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".

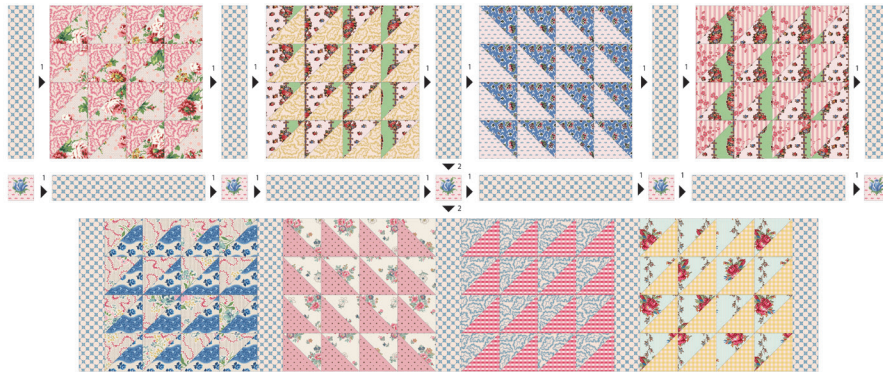


Make 20
Using 2 contrasting
fabrics for each block

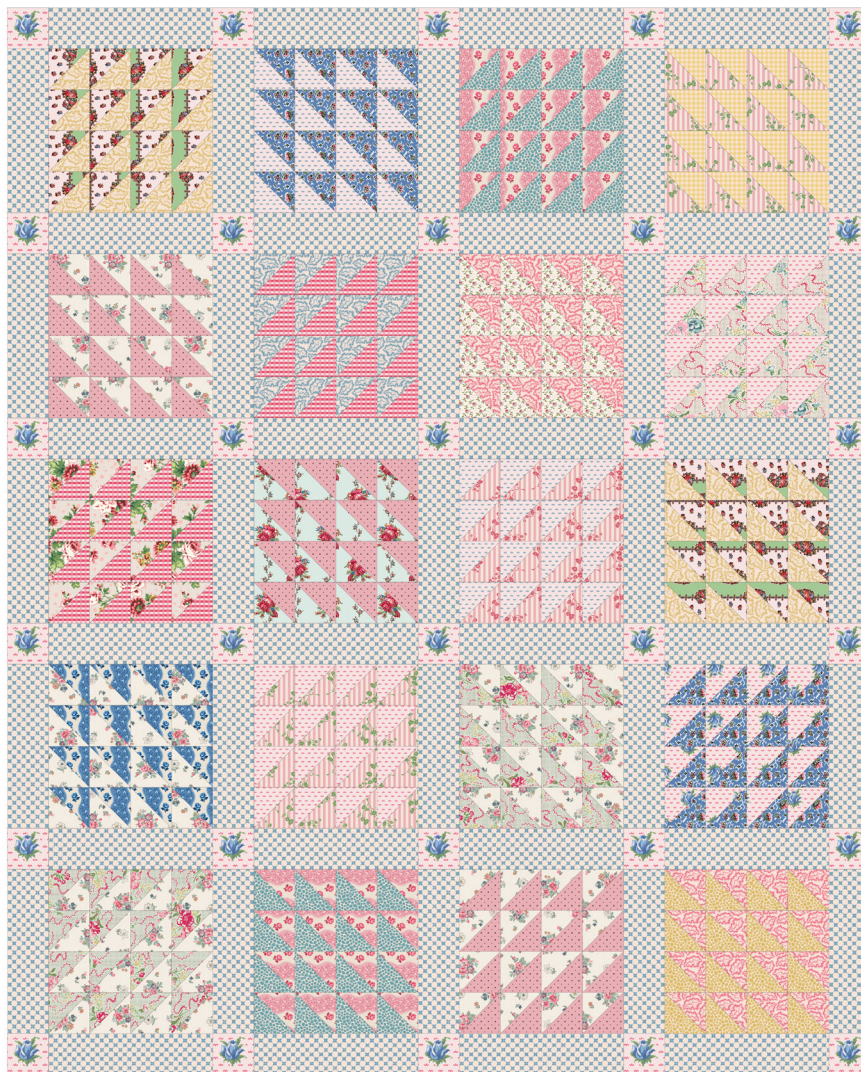

Step 3

Cut 49 strips of sashing at $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " in DV7673. Then fussy cut 30 squares from DV7660 at $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " for the posts. Sew together as per the diagram below; 5 rows in total

MATERIALS

By Judy Newman

Quilt Size: 60" x 72" (152cm x 182cm)
Machine made

- 65cm DV7673 sashing
- 65cm DV7660 Rosebud for posts - fussy cut
- Fat 1/8ths bundle of the collection for the blocks
- 3.5m backing fabric
- 50cm binding of your choice

Quilt as desired
