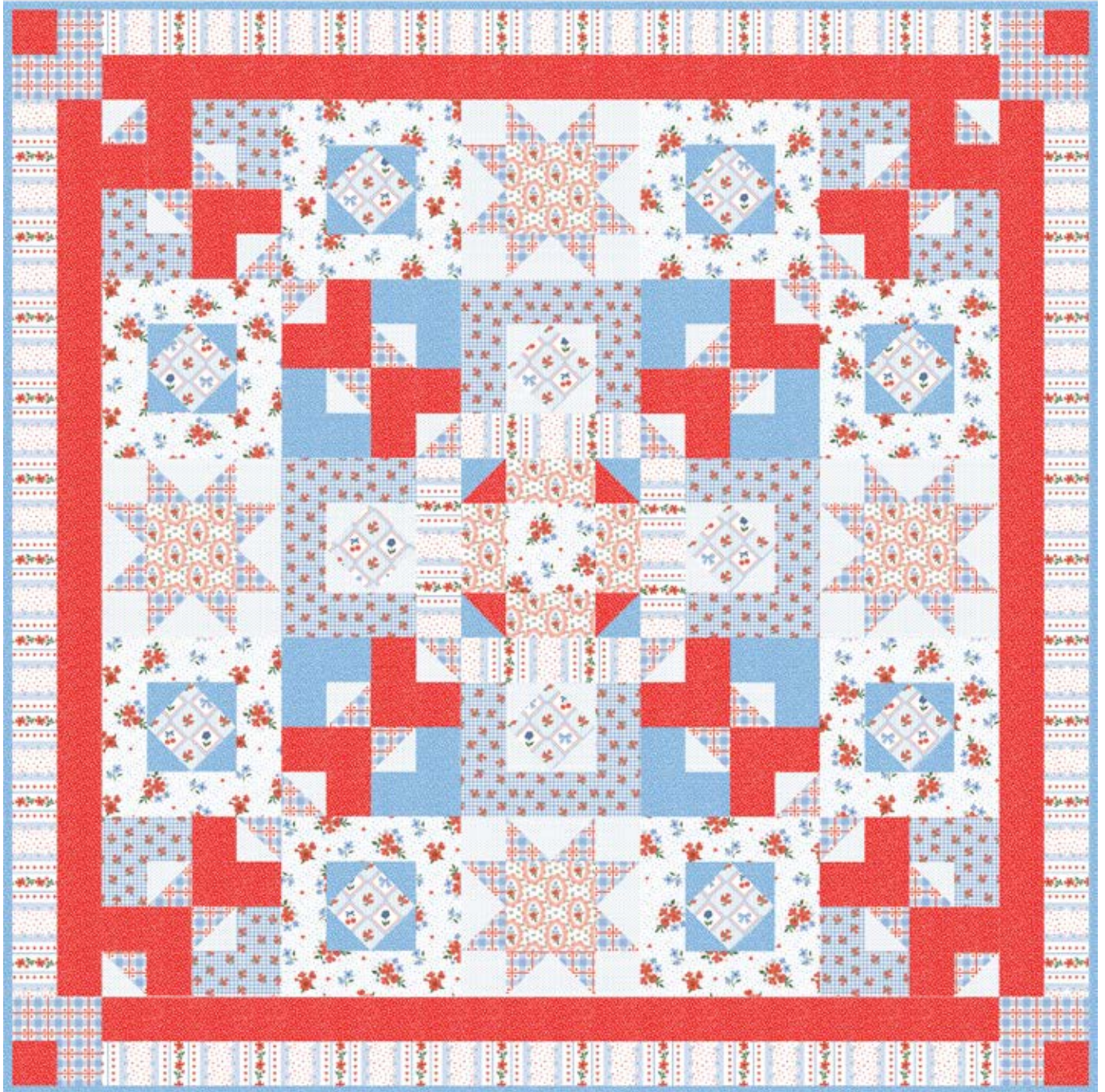

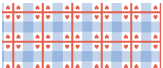

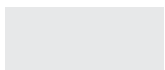

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From the check DV7982 fabric cut:

- 4 10 ½" x 3" strips
- 16 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 18 3" squares



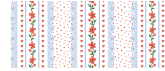
From the Floral DV7985 fabric cut:

- 16 10 ½" x 3" strips
- 16 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 1 5 ½" square



From the border DV7980 fabric cut:

- 8 3" x 26" strips for border piecing
- 4 10 ½" x 3" strips



From the morif stripe DV7983 fabric cut:

- 12 5 ½" squares



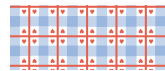
From the Motif oval DV7981 fabric cut:

- 4 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 4 5 ½" squares



From the Motif oval DV7984 fabric cut:

- 4 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 52 3" squares



From the blue confetti DV2272 fabric cut:

- 8 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 42 3" squares
- 8 2 ½" strips for binding



From the red confetti DV2272 fabric cut:

- 16 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 22 3" squares
- 8 3" x 26" strips for border piecing



From the Blue dot DV2949 fabric cut:

- 16 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
- 48 3" squares

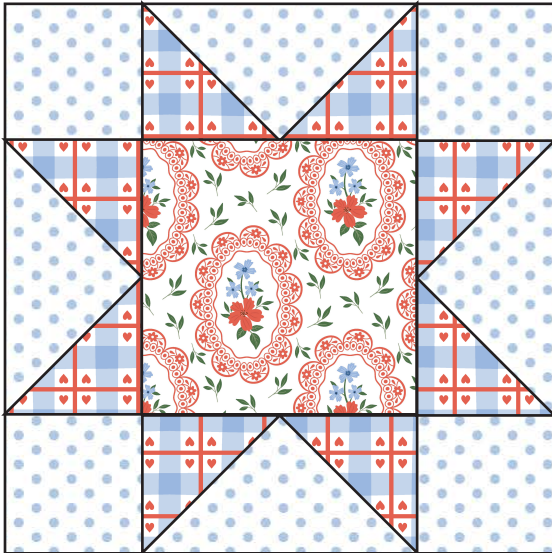


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

*Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.
1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.
Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.*

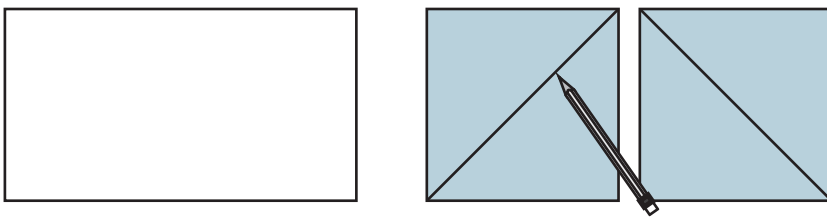
Follow the instructions to make the following blocks.

Star blocks - make 4

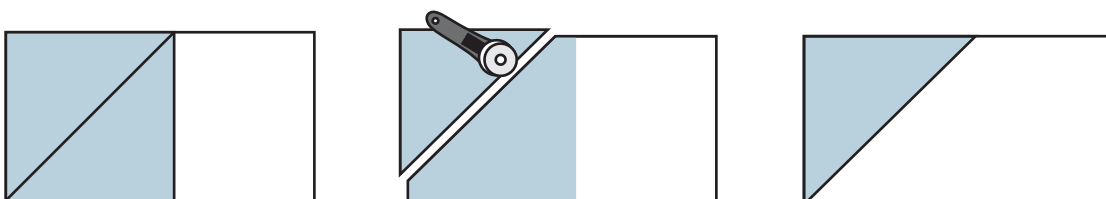


Flying Geese

Take your 5 1/2" x 3" blue dot rectangles and blue check 3" squares.
Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.

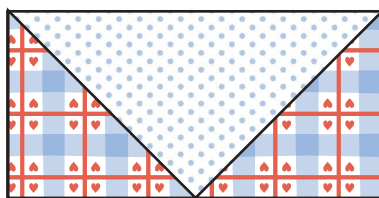
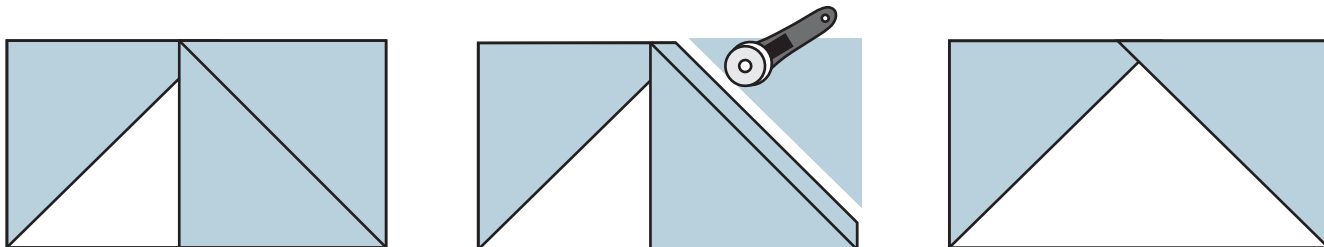


Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectangle, ensuring sides match up.
Sew along the diagonal line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



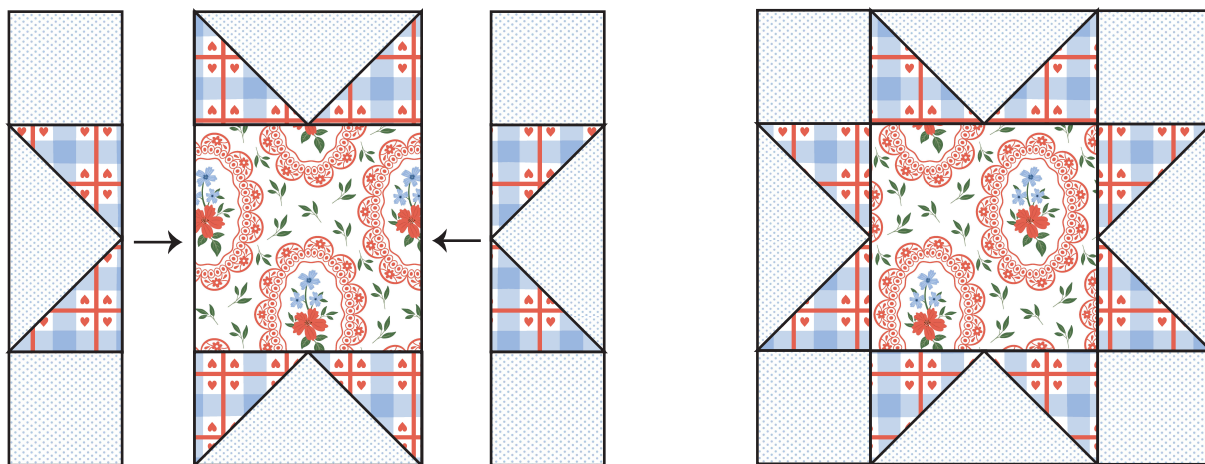
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



Make 4

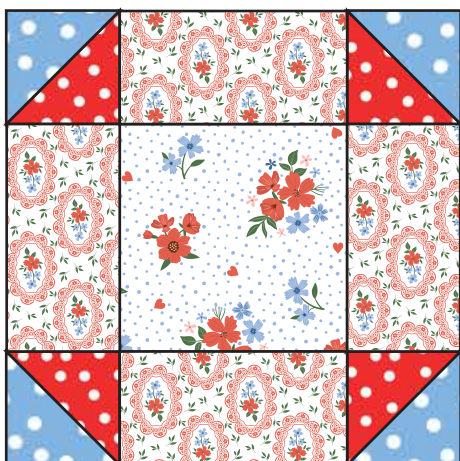
Take your motif 5 1/2" square and 4 blue dot 3" squares and sew your star block as shown. Press. Your block should measure 10 1/2".

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Make the centre block following the instructions below.



Make 1

Take your floral 5 1/2" square, 4 motif 5 1/2" x 3" rectangles and 2 red confetti and blue confetti 3" squares.

Make your 4 half square triangle blocks following the instructions.

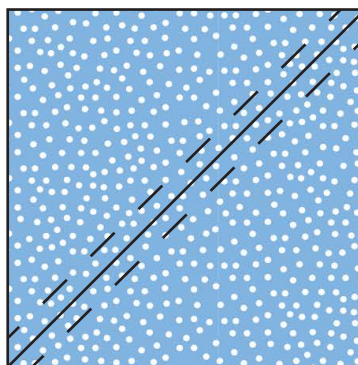
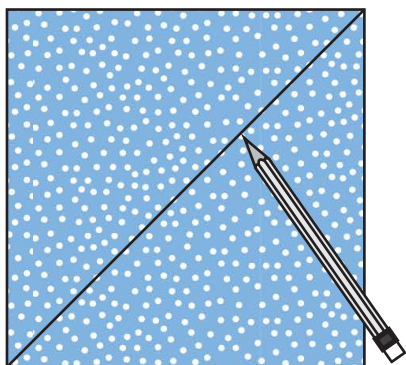
Half square triangle blocks (instructions are to make 2 at a time).

Make 4

Place your squares right sides together.

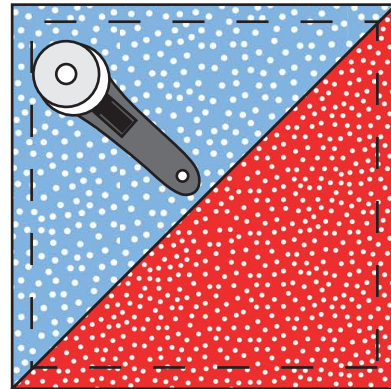
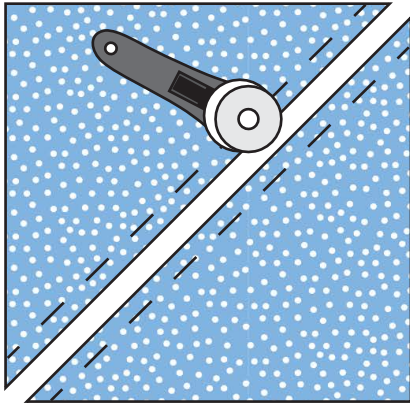
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line.

Sew the squares a scant 1/4" away along each side of the cutting line.

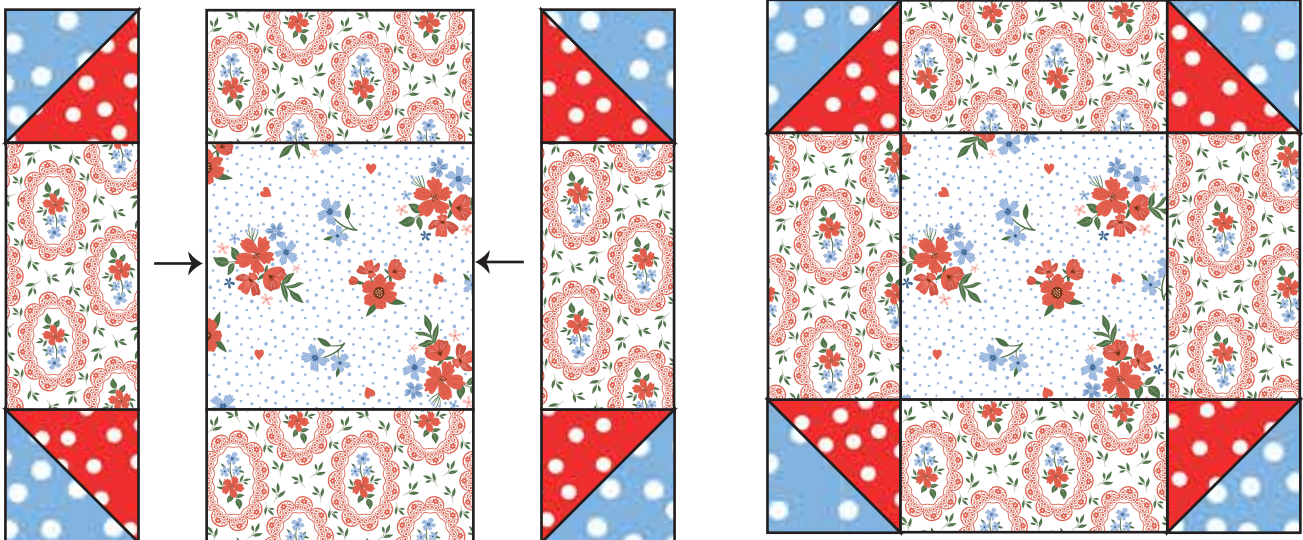


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Cut in half diagonally along the drawn line.
Open and press the seam towards the darker coloured side.
Trim your squares back to 3".



Take your remaining pieces and sew your block together as shown. Press. your block should measure 10 ½".



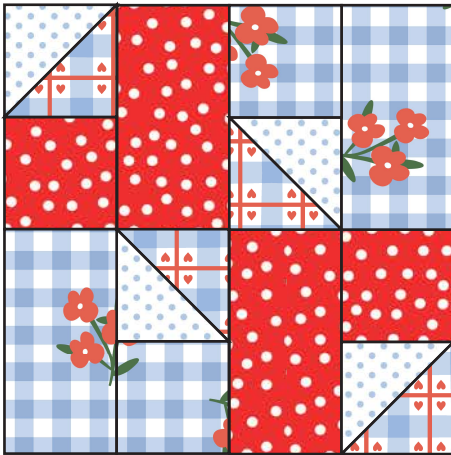

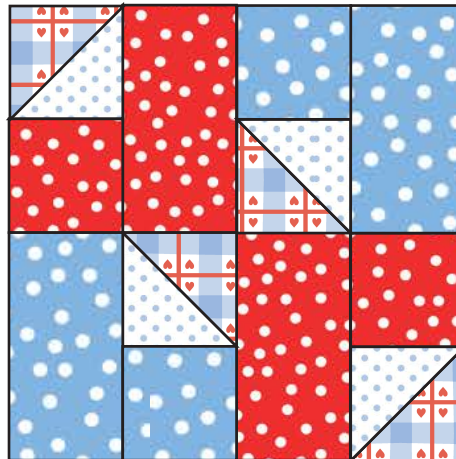
Assemble the following pieces:

8 check 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 8 red confetti 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 8 red confetti 3" squares
 8 grid 3" squares
 8 check 3" squares
 8 blue dot 3" squares

8 blue confetti 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 8 red confetti 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 8 red confetti 3" squares
 8 blue confetti 3" squares
 8 grid 3" squares
 8 blue dot 3" squares

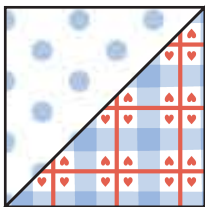

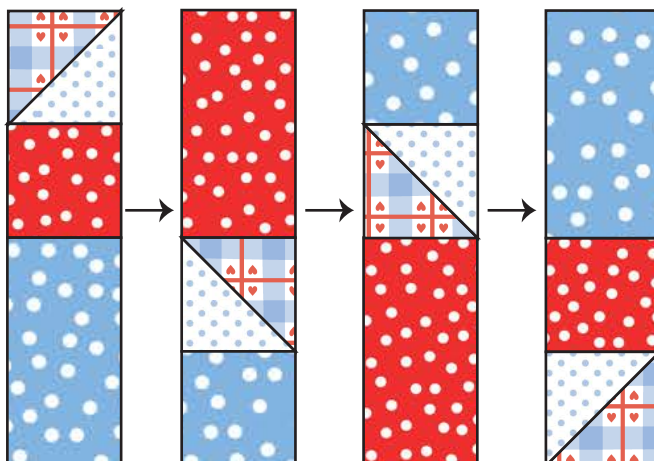

Make 8 grid and blue dot half square triangles using the half square triangle instructions as before.



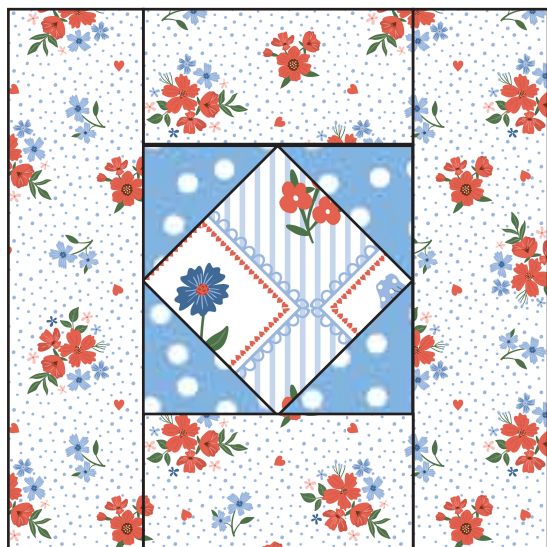

Sew your blocks following the diagrams. Press. Your blocks should measure 10 ½".



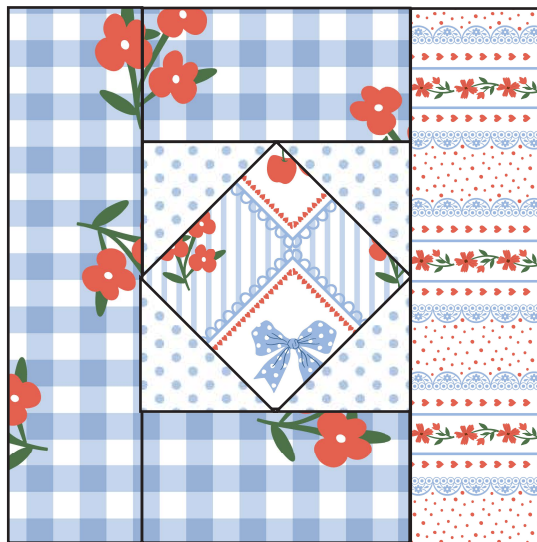
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Assemble the following pieces:
 16 floral 10 ½" x 3" rectangles
 16 floral 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 32 blue confetti 3" squares
 8 motif stripe 5 ½" squares



Make 8

Assemble the following pieces:
 4 check 10 ½" x 3" rectangles
 4 border 10 ½" x 3" rectangles
 8 check 5 ½" x 3" rectangles
 16 blue dot 3" squares
 4 motif stripe 5 ½" square



Make 4

Make 8 stitch and flip square blocks following the same method as for your flying geese blocks.

Start by sewing 2 small squares across each corner of the large square, at opposite corners from each other.

Trim the corners as you go and press seams towards the darker side.

Finish by sewing the 2 remaining corners, trim and press.

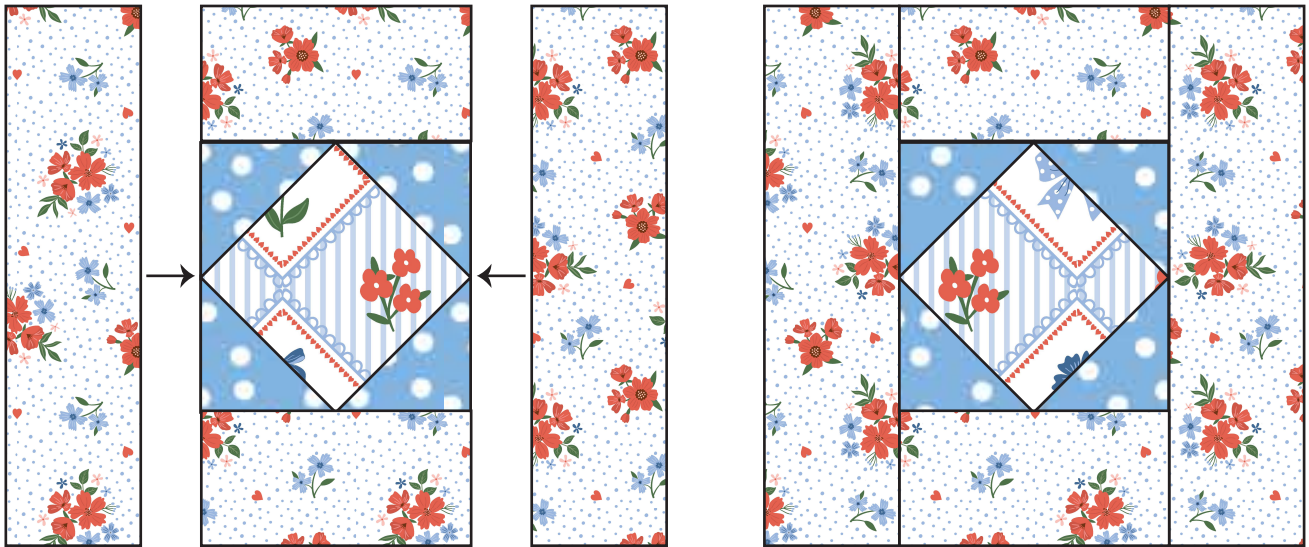
Your centre block should measure 5 ½".



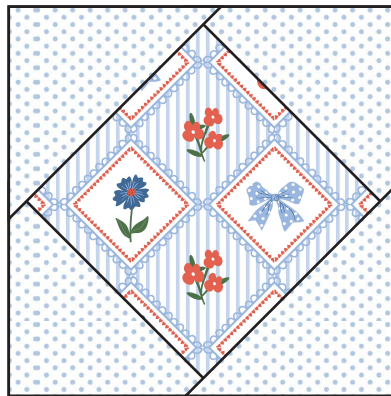
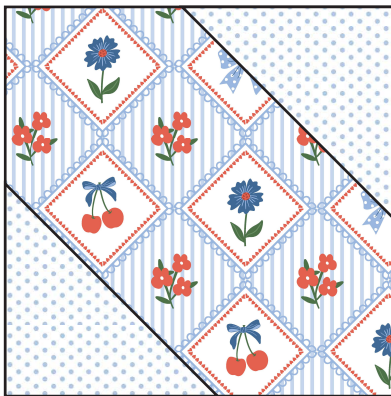

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Start assembling your quilt by sewing your blocks together in rows as follows. Press and join all rows together.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Sew your red confetti and border 26" strips together in pairs to make four 51 ½" strips of each colour.

Sew your red confetti borders to your stripe border piece as shown.



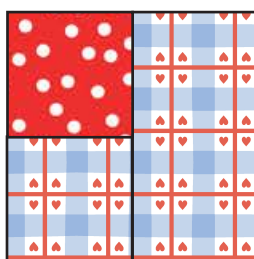

Assemble the following pieces:

4 grid 5 ½" x 3" rectangles

4 grid 3" squares

4 red confetti 3" squares

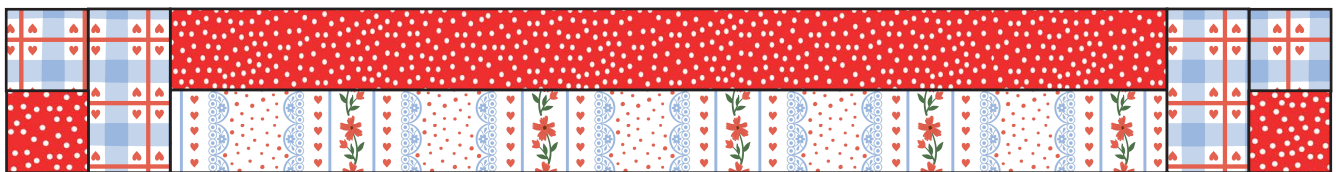
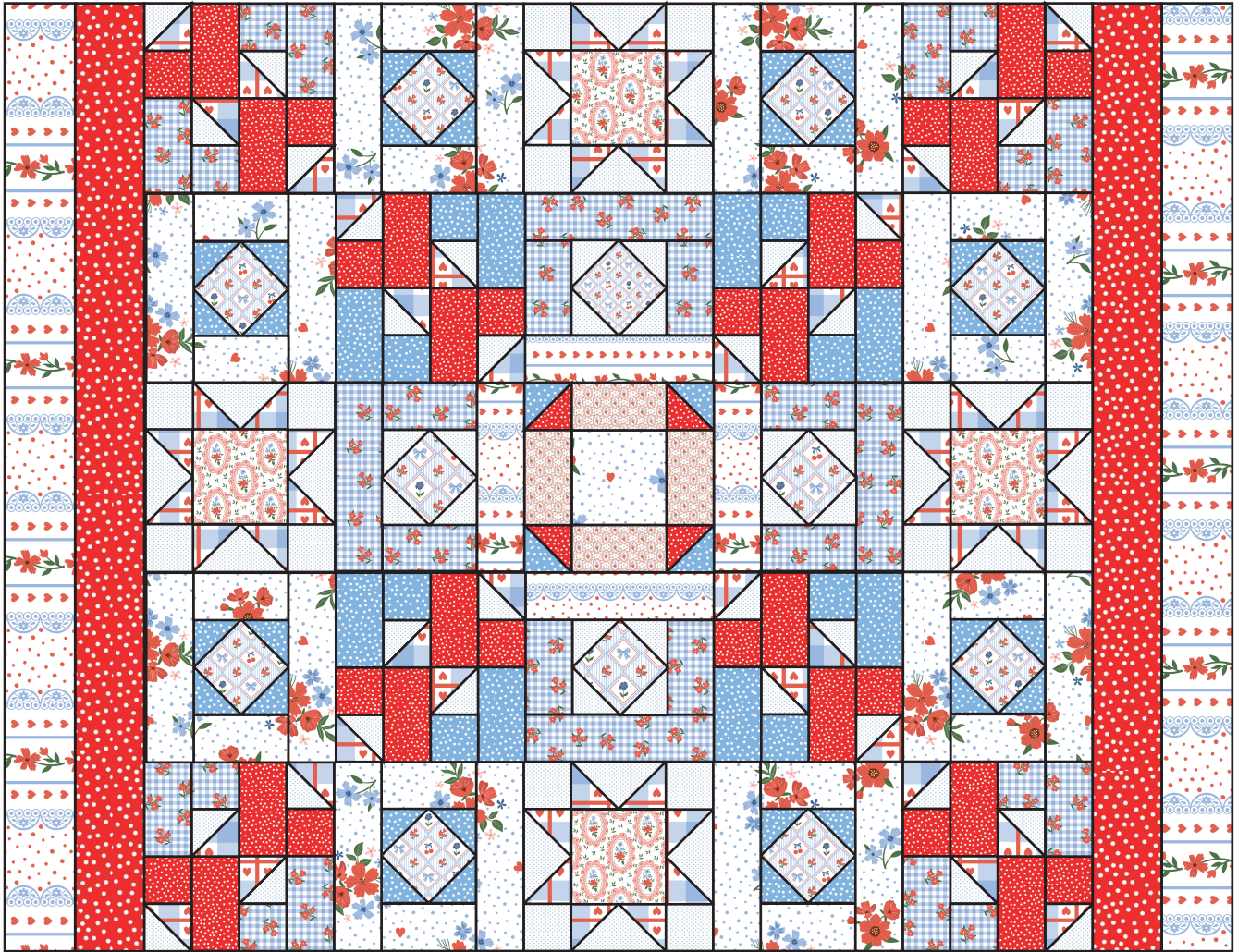
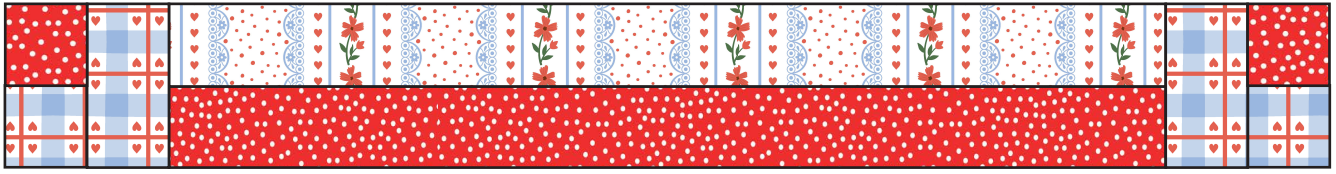
Add your corner pieced blocks to each side of 2 border sections. Press.

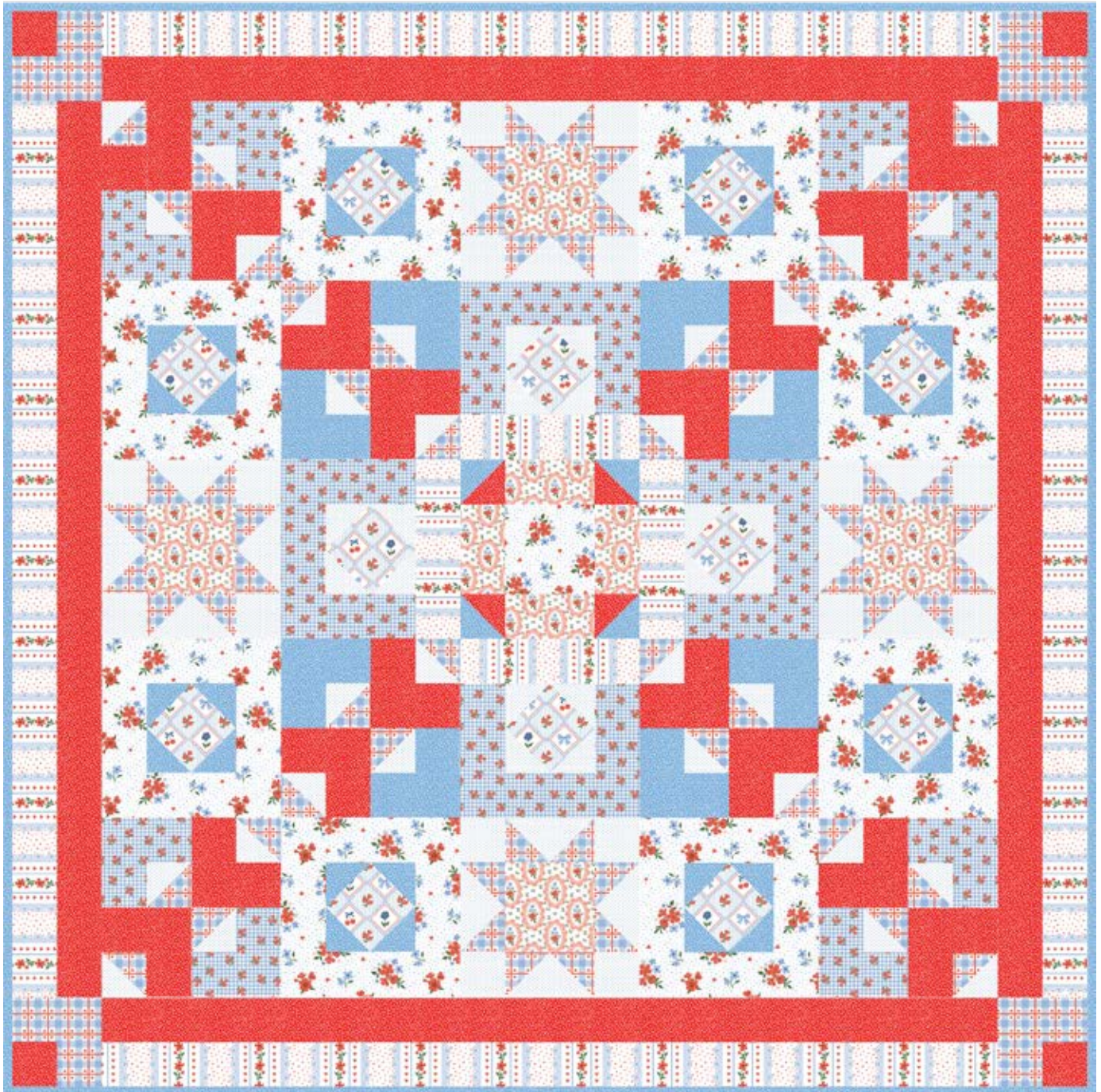
Finally, add your pieced border strips in the same way, sewing the shorter pieces to the sides of your quilt first, then sewing the top and bottom pieces to finish.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Layer your quilt top, wadding and backing and glue baste together. Quilt using your preferred method.

Sew your binding strips together end to end then add binding to your trimmed quilt to finish.
