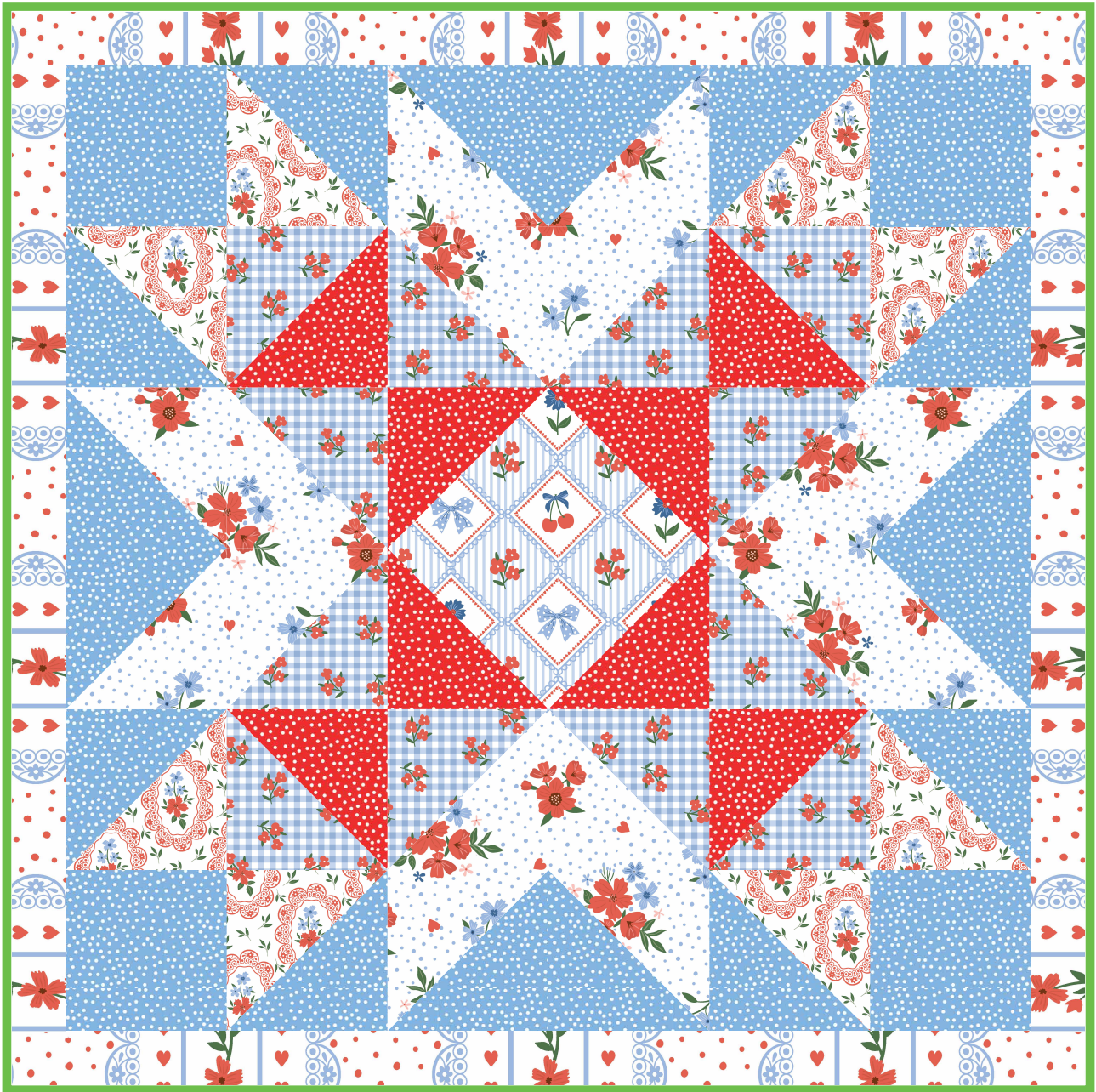

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Project size 20"square, perfect for cushion or large tote. requirtements are to make one block

Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing.

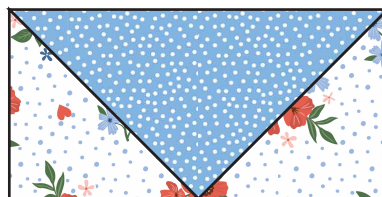
1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.

Follow the instructions to make the following blocks.

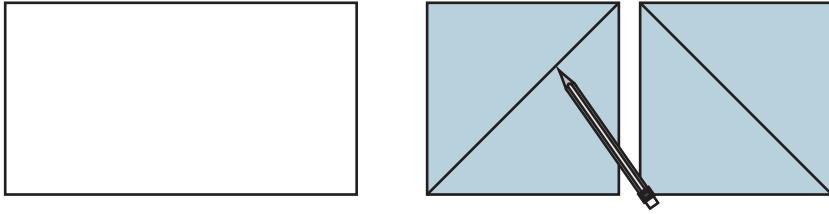

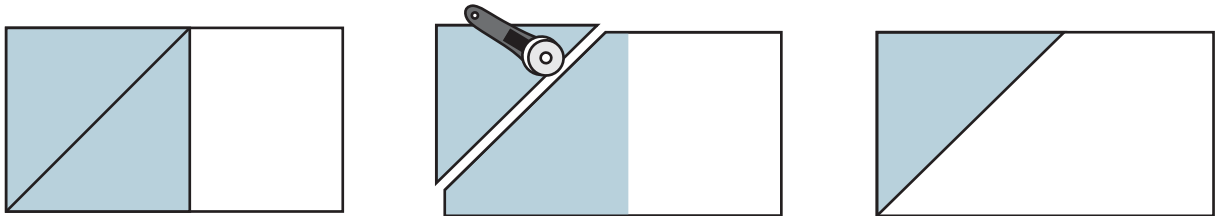
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Flying Geese on at a time method

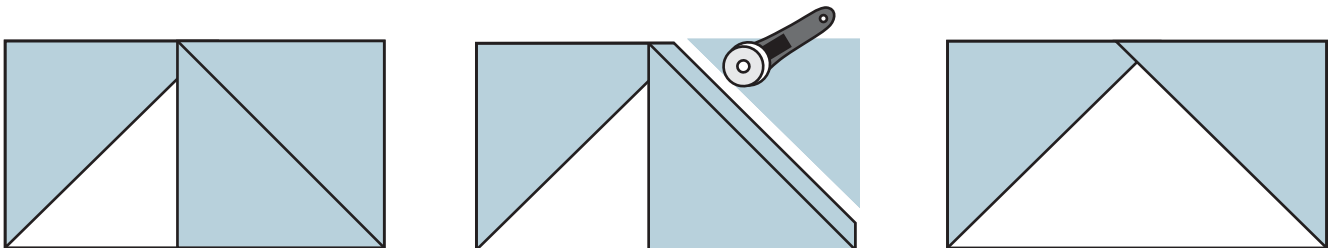
Take your $6\frac{3}{4}" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ rectangles and contrasting $3\frac{3}{4}"$ squares.
Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.



Place 1 square right sides together on top of the rectangle, ensuring sides match up.
Sew along the diagonal line.
Trim off excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



Take the second square and place face down on top of the rectangle.
Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.
Trim off excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from sewn line.
Fold out and press.



In the same way, make your stitch and flip centre block as shown.
Fold out and press.

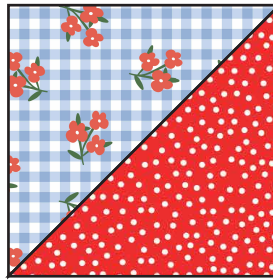
PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Half square triangles

Make the following half square triangles. Fold out and press.



Make 8



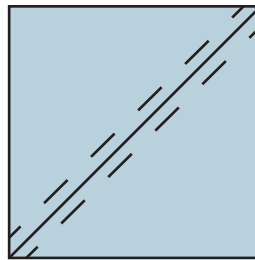
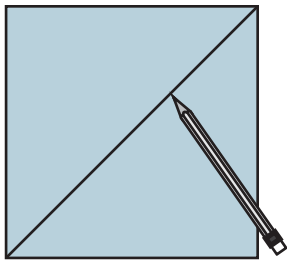
Make 4

Half square triangle blocks (instructions are to make 2 at a time).

Place your squares right sides together.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line.

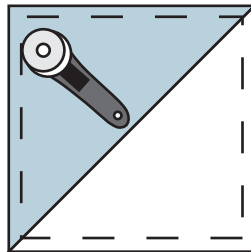
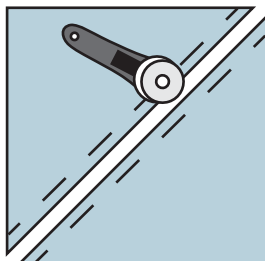
Sew the squares a scant 1/4" away along each side of the cutting line.



Cut in half diagonally along the drawn line.

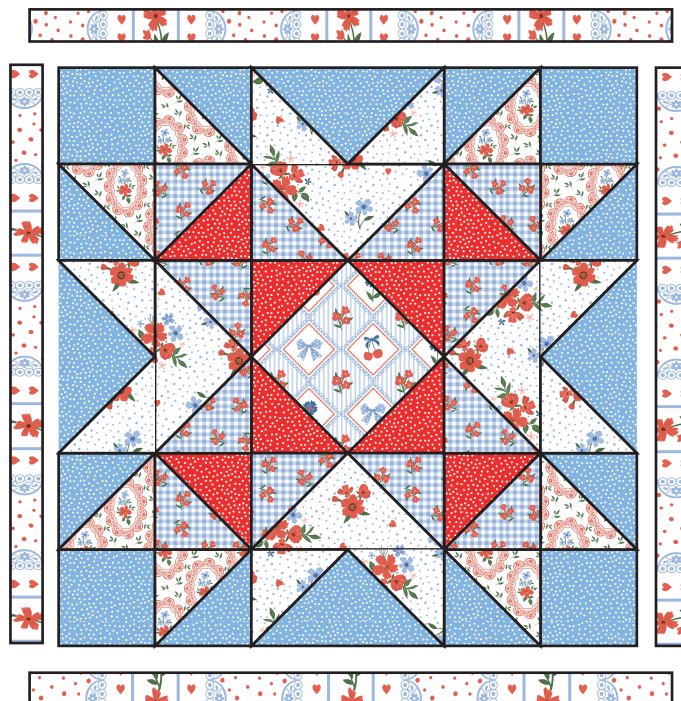
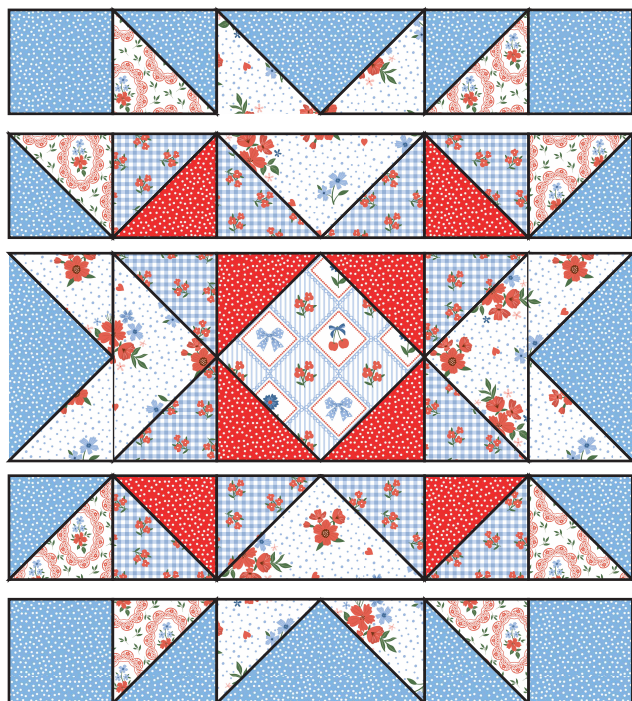
Open and press the seam towards the darker coloured side.

Trim your squares back to 3 1/2" if required.

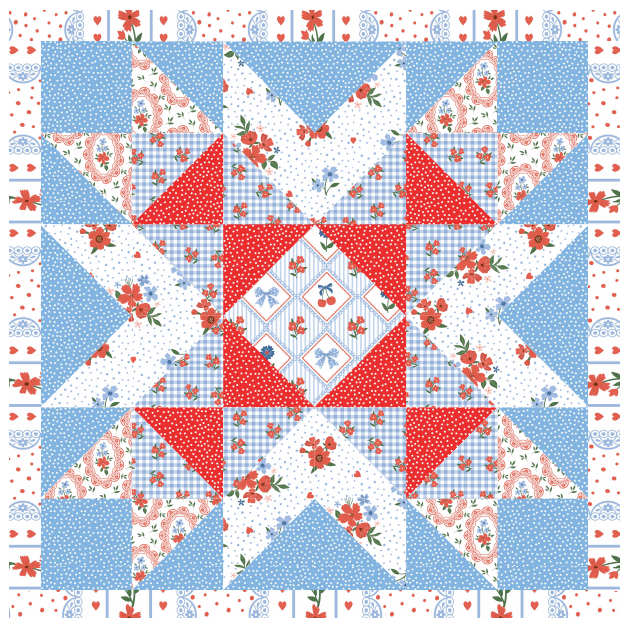


PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Take your blocks and remaining squares and assemble your block in rows following the diagram below.



Add your border strips, sewing the shorter side pieces first then sewing the top and bottom pieces to finish your block.



Add backing and zipper to make into a cushion, walling hanging or tote bag.
