

WILLOWDROOK MARKET BARDEN



Fabrics Required ~ Willowbrook Market Garden Panel, 10x Fat 1/8's of Coloured Prints for Stars, Fat 1/8 print for Cornerstones, Fat 1/8 print for Flying Geese, 70cm Red/Cream Spot for Sashings, 75cm Pink Spot for Border, 1m Cream Spot Background ~ Finished Size: 47½" x 57"

Trim picture panel to: 20, 4½" squares

From cream spot, cut: 80, 4½ x 2½ rectangles (star background)

80, 21/2" squares (star background)

From each of 10 coloured prints, cut: $16, 2\frac{1}{2}$ squares (star points)

From red spot fabric, cut:

From yellow pears, cut:

From cream bee print, cut:

From pink spot, cut:

49, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" pieces (sashing)

30, 2" squares (cornerstone squares)

12, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces (border flying geese) two $35\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces (side border A)

two 8½" x 4½" pieces (side border B)

two 30" x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces (top/bottom border A) two $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces (top/bottom border B)

 $24, 2\frac{1}{2}$ squares (border flying geese)


Seam allowance is included in measurements given

On the back of the coloured 2½" squares, rule a diagonal line from corner to corner.




Place one of these squares, right sides together, with one of the cream spot $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces, at one end of the rectangle. Sew a needle-width outside the marked line.







Sew two of the rectangles to two opposite sides of a 4½" picture square, so that the star points, point out from the centre.








Make 20 star blocks. Join star blocks into five rows of four, with sashing pieces between. Sew sashing into rows with a cornerstone square between. Insert between rows.

Use the same method for side portion of the star blocks, to make the Flying Geese blocks, with the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " cream bee print and the pink spot $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Make 12 blocks.

Sew these together in four lots of three. Insert into the pink border pieces as shown:



Sew on side borders first, then top and bottom borders. Follow the colour picture for placement direction.
